Temporary Housing Assistance - applicants can receive financial assistance to reimburse lodging expenses and/or rental assistance for up to 18 months. Applicants can receive direct housing assistance (FEMA mobile home or travel trailer) for up to 18 months. 2. Repair Assistance – owners can receive up to the IHP cap for repairs 3. Replace Assistance – owners with destroyed homes can receive up to the IHP cap towards the purchase of a new home 4.
