



Tour Funding Policy

Any age group or team can begin collecting funds towards the U12s Tour at any time. We do however suggest that you set a bank account in your teams name to administer these funds.

If you set up a bank account in the teams name to accumulate tour funds it is the sole responsibility of the team to administer the account. Crofton Saints Youth Football Club cannot accept responsibility for these accounts.

If there is more than one team in the U12 age group then funds collected by a single team are solely for that teams use. Funds collected by individual teams WILL NOT be centralised and redistributed amongst the other teams.

Club Subsidy

CSYFL will donate £1,000 per team up to a maximum of 3 teams in the U12 age group towards their chosen tour(s). This subsidy MAY increase pro-rata if there are less than 3 teams within the age group. All subsidies are derived from profits made from the club's annual tournament. Consequently, in order to qualify for a subsidy, the corresponding teams (when they are the U11 age group) are required to provide the manpower for the BBQ facility throughout the whole weekends' duration of the tournament. The only exception will be when they are participating in the tournament when cover will be arranged. All subsidies given are at the discretion of the Crofton Saints Youth Football Club Executive Committee.

Club Organised Events

Teams are actively encouraged to arrange and undertake fundraising activities e.g. car washing, supermarket bag packing etc. However, Crofton Saints Youth Football Club will organise one quiz night each year from which the proceeds will go into the that seasons tour fund to be divided equally among the number of teams at the U12 age group.
