Here's the breakdown of what we are doing!



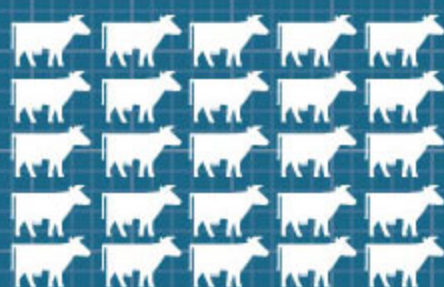
We're helping individuals transition from homelessness to permanent housing.
