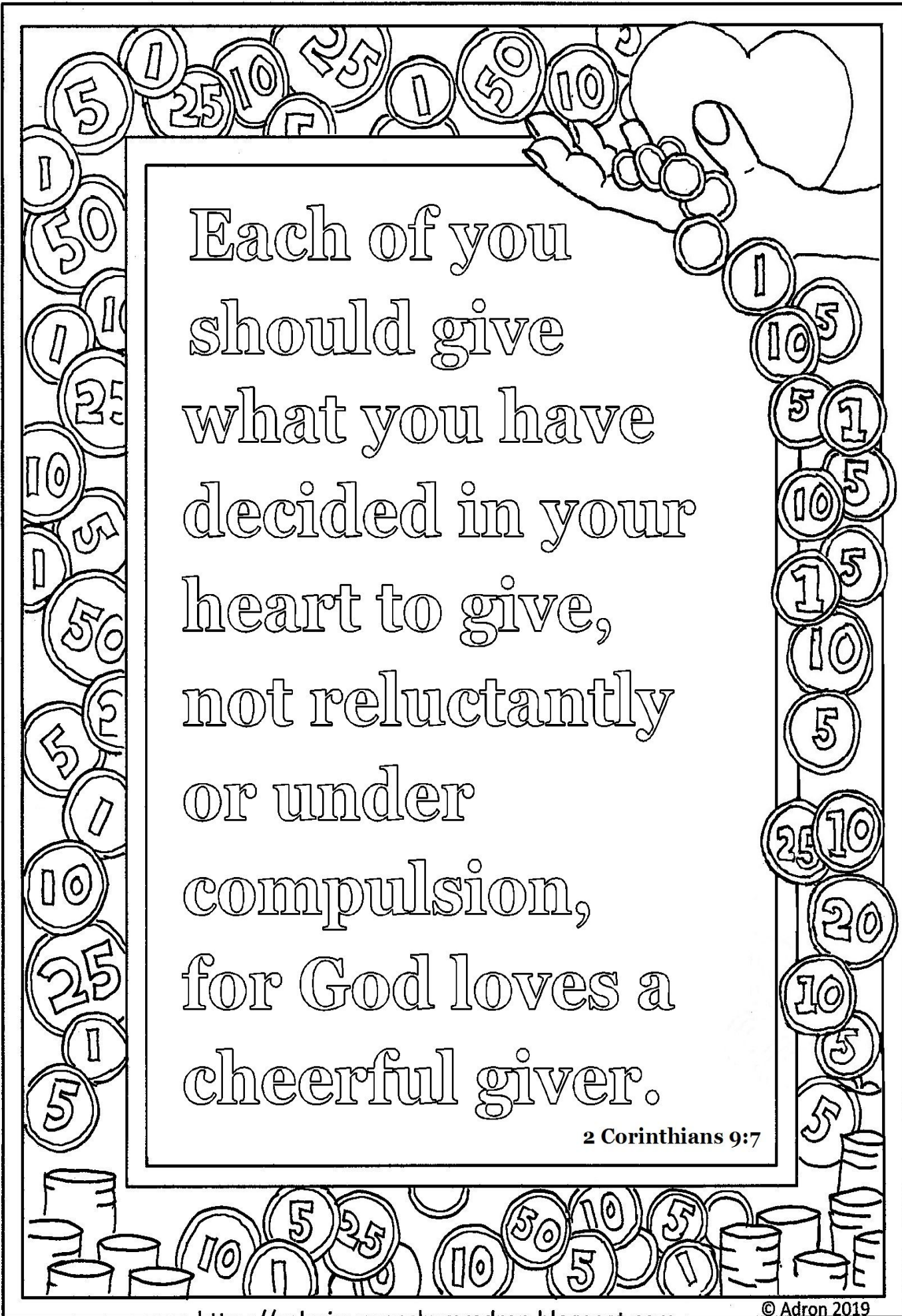
ACROSS

- Having great material wealth

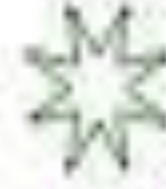
