

Covid Safe Meetings at Central House

What can I expect?



On Arrival
If you are coming with children, please try to arrive 5 minutes early to drop them to kids work
If others are arriving at the same time, form a queue observing a 2 metre gap between households
Ensure you are wearing a face covering before entering the building
On entry, sanitise your hands from dispenser in the foyer
Use the NHS app to scan QR code for Track & Trace
You will be shown to your allocated seats with your family name displayed, do not move chairs
Doors will be propped open to minimise contact with push-plates etc.
A one-way system will be operating for entry/exit
Children
Kids work for children aged 3 to 11 will take place upstairs
One parent should take children up, ensuring there is no one else on the stairs
Children and kids workers do not need to wear face coverings
Children under 3 will remain with parents and must not be allowed to roam around the room
During the Meeting
Face coverings must be worn for the duration of the meeting except those leading the meeting
Only worship leaders are permitted to sing
Praying out is allowed - but face masks must stay on
Households must remain distanced from each other - by 2 metres
Sadly, no interaction between households is allowed - that is possible outside after the meeting
Toilets are available
After the Meeting
Please leave the building promptly at the end of the meeting
One parent collect children, again ensuring distancing on the stairs
Outside the building, please observe rules regarding interaction with one other household or 6 people
