

WEEK ONE | SET APART

Day 1:

Scripture: "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them." Ephesians 2:10

Devotional: God in Christ Jesus has made us new and prepared good works for us in advance. Have you invited God to lead and willingly submitted to His will today?

Day 2:

Scripture: "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for His own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him." 1 Peter 2:9

Devotional: We are a chosen people, set apart for God, His very own possession. How does knowing you were created to proclaim God's praise compel you to live today?

Day 3:

Scripture: "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will." Romans 12:2

Devotional: As God's ambassadors, we don't squeeze into the world's mold, we live transformed lives for God. How does God's Word lead you from information to transformation?

Day 4:

Scripture: "If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you." John 15:19

Devotional: We live in opposition to the world because of God's call to holiness. How does being distinctive for Jesus inform your life and lifestyle even in suffering?

Day 5:

Scripture: "Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation: The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." 2 Corinthians 5:17

Devotional: When Jesus changes a life, He changes it from the inside out. A fresh start. What does it mean to live free of shame and full of promise and hope?

Day 6:

Scripture: "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." Galatians 2:10

Devotional: When Jesus becomes Savior and Lord a brand new identity begins. How should we live now, knowing we are the "property of Christ"?

Day 7:

Scripture: "Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children." Ephesians 5:1

Devotional: Having become a part of God's family, we now live as imitators and dearly loved children. Having this treasure, how does it look like to please God rather than men?

WEEK TWO | FORGIVE AND REPENT

Day 8:

Scripture: "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your heavenly Father forgive you." Matthew 6:14-15

Devotional: Forgiveness of others is not optional. How can your heavenly perspective lead you into forgiveness of others?

Day 9:

Scripture: "But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" Matthew 5:44

Devotional: God commands us to pray for our enemies. Is there a fractured relationship or an "enemy" in your life that you need to pray for? How can you take this to God in prayer?

Day 10:

Scripture: "Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed." James 5:16

Devotional: How can you confess and repent to God and others this week? How does accountability play a role in your spiritual life?

Day 11:

Scripture: "if my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land." 2 Chronicles 7:14

Devotional: How can you prayerfully humble yourself today and turn from evil? God's promise as we obey Him is that He will hear, forgive and heal.

Day 12:

Scripture: "Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." Matthew 26:41

Devotional: How can you turn to prayer today, instead of falling into temptation? How can you go to God in repentance today?

Day 13:

Scripture: "I desire then that in every place the men should pray, lifting holy hands without anger or quarreling;" 1 Timothy 2:8

Devotional: As Jesus is the mediator between mankind and God, how can you invite Him to be the mediator in your own relationships with others?

Day 14:

Scripture: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

Devotional: The Lord forgives us when we confess and go to Him in an attitude of repentance. How is your heart postured in repentance today?

WEEK THREE | INVITE GOD**Day 15:**

Scripture: "The LORD is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth." Psalm 145:18

Devotional: When you call on the Lord in prayer, he hears you, will help you and is with you. What does it look like to invite God to take up His rightful place and become intimately near?

Day 16:

Scripture: "Seek the Lord and His strength; seek His presence continually!" 1 Chronicles 16:11

Devotional: God promises, "you will find me when you seek me with all your heart." (Jer 29:13) How can you seek the Lord genuinely to allow His strength and comfort to enter your life uniquely?

Day 17:

Scripture: "And when you pray, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do, for they think that they will be heard for their many words." Matthew 6:7

Devotional: God wants to hear from His children.. How can you be sincere with Him in your prayers today?

Day 18:

Scripture: "You will make your prayer to Him, and He will hear you, and you will pay your vows." Job 22:27

Devotional: God delights in answering prayer. Knowing that God hears you, how can you pray with confidence expecting to give God glory as He responds.

Day 19:

Scripture: "Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise." James 5:13

Devotional: Invite God into the hardships and the joys in your life! How can you praise God in your life for both your troubles and happiness?

Day 20:

Scripture: "And this is the confidence that we have before Him: If we ask anything according to His will, He hears us." 1 John 5:14

Devotional: Prayer is communing with God. How will you pray knowing God's pleasure is in fulfilling His will in the lives of His children.

Day 21:

Scripture: "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to Him and eat with Him, and he with Me." Revelation 3:20

Devotional: God is seeking after us, knocking at our door. How will you answer His call?
