# What is Discipleship?

- The term Discipleship is not in the Bible. This term is the process of being a Disciple or making Disciples.
- Discipleship is a growth process.

# How do I advance my Discipleship?

- One of the most powerful benefits of being a Disciple is that we are part of the family of God.
- The community of Disciples is to support, encourage and correct each other. As a Disciple I must be willing to be accountable for how I represent God.
- I must be willing to seek God for a community of Disciples that will nurture me.
- Discipleship is for me to grow as a Disciple and get prepared to make Disciples.
- Discipleship goes beyond attendance in services. Discipleship is focused on me and my growth to serve God with my life.

# My Discipleship Journey

- There is no specific method for developing Disciples.
- Your Discipleship Journey should follow the principles that Yeshua used to develop the original twelve.
- In Matthew 28:18-20 Yeshua instructed the Disciples to:
  1. Go make Disciples – this means we need to be actively seeking and investing in people to be committed followers of God through Yeshua.
  2. Teaching them to obey what I commanded you – the teachings of Yeshua are the foundation of how Disciples live and are the objective of everyone who commits to being a Disciple. We are to learn His teachings and then share them with others while we strive to live them daily.
  3. Baptizing them – we are to encourage believers to be baptized to witness their commitment and willingness to be transformed.
  4. I (Yeshua) will be with you – as a committed Disciple Yeshua is with you always. In your thoughts and actions. You are always focused on His will and teachings. He is also with us through the Holy Spirit. We surrender daily to be led by the Holy Spirit to know God's will and plan for us.
