2. Judas brought soldiers with weapons to find Jesus. What were they expecting? Despite this, who initiated the dialogue? Was Jesus trying to hide? What does this tell us about the authority of Jesus, even in a moment of unrest such as this (when situations might *seem* 'out of control')?
3. We said on Sunday that NOTHING catches Jesus by surprise. How can this speak comfort into our daily living?
4. When Jesus responded, "I am" (verse 8), what did the crowds do in response? How does John's inclusion of this detail help accomplish his purpose in writing this gospel (See John 20:31)?
5. Although what Peter did might have seemed noble and brave, he was wrong. In what ways? (See Proverbs 10:2 and Romans 10:2.) Describe a time when you've displayed zeal but lacked knowledge / a time when perhaps you should not have 'drawn your sword'. What were the results/ consequences?
