

# THE BIGGER THEY ARE THE HARDER THEY FALL

(1 Samuel 17)

## Part 3

1. Knowing the battle belongs to the Lord and His power rules, I can run **TO** the battle, not **FROM** it. (*Matthew 26:39; Philippians 2:8; 2 Chronicles 20:15,17; Joshua 1:9; 2 Timothy 1:7; 2 Thessalonians 3:3; Deuteronomy 20:4*)
2. Anything and anyone set against God will **FALL**. (*1 Samuel 5:2-3; Romans 14:11; Philippians 2:9-11; Isaiah 2:17, 54:17; Psalm 27:1-3; Deuteronomy 28:7*)
3. In Christ, we don't just barely make it - we **PREVAIL**! (*Romans 5:6-8, 8:35,37; Colossians 2:15; Psalm 35:7-9; 1 John 3:8, 5:4; John 16:33; 1 Corinthians 15:57*)
4. Like the Philistines, the world around us is trusting in a giant that will **LET THEM DOWN**. May we never do this! (*Psalm 20:7-8, 62:1-2, 118:8-9, 121:3-4; Isaiah 31:1, 42:17; Romans 12:2*)
5. God always gets the **FINAL WORD**. (*Proverbs 16:33, 19:21; 1 Peter 3:22*)
