

# RESURRECTION CRAFT FOR EASTER

“He has risen!” Mathew 28:6. That’s what Easter is all about. With bunnies, eggs, and Easter baskets, children can get distracted from its true meaning. Here is a simple craft to do with your kids to help them remember the reason we celebrate Easter.



## SUPPLIES FOR A RESURRECTION CRAFT

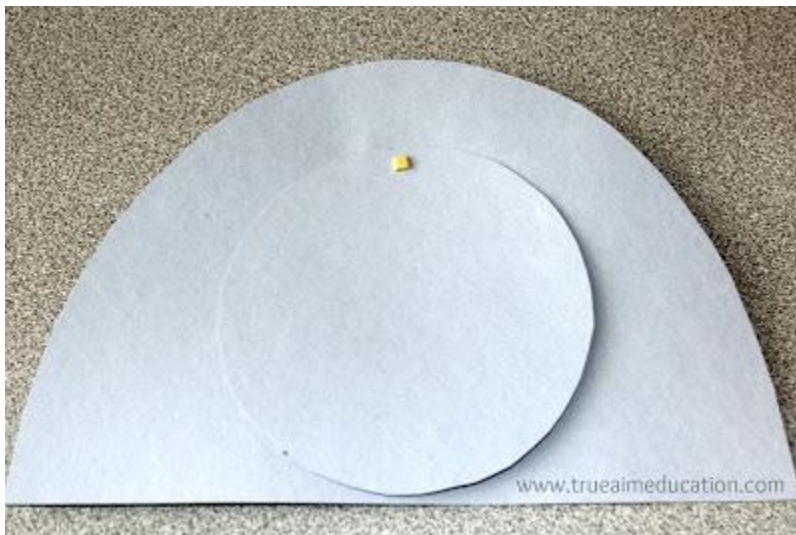
You’ll need: Scissors, a brad, coloring supplies, and this handy template. The images for the craft are on the second document.

You have two choices:

1. You can use colored construction paper like I did below or,
2. You can print it out on white paper and allow your children to color a scene around the tomb. My oldest daughter likes to do this because she can draw animals and people that have come to see Jesus.
3. To make our “tomb”, we first painted our picture of Jesus. I helped the children cut out the hole in the middle of the tomb. Then, we cut Jesus’ picture out and taped it to the back. Remember to score your paper for the brad so you can “roll away the stone”.



Place the extra circle over the hole of the tomb and fasten it with a brad.



After our craft we talked about the importance of Jesus rising from the dead. Apart from Jesus' being born, it is the most important event in the history of Christianity.
