



Dear THRIVE Parents,

Since restarting THRIVE Kids this past March, we have had an incredible time with your children! We are so thankful to be able to come alongside you in discipling your child in the truth and love of Jesus Christ, and we are blessed to have new children and families join us each week!

We have continued to seek the Lord's guidance on how to best care for our children and leaders during COVID-19. On May 28, some changes went into effect in the Commonwealth of Virginia related to COVID-19 protocol. Given these changes, and given the CDC general guidelines, we will be modifying some of our protocol.

The following changes will be initiated on June 6, 2021:

- Masks: It will left to the individual teacher's and helper's personal discretion whether or not to wear a mask. It will also be left to the parents' discretion whether or not their child will wear a mask. (We will still have some masks available for those who desire one.)
- Temperature Checks: We will no longer be conducting temperature checks at check-in. (As always, if you suspect your child has a fever, check it at home before arriving at church. If your child has been feeling sick, has a fever, cough, or any other symptoms of illness, please do not bring them.)
- Boundaries: We will no longer be separating the PreK-5th graders in their space. (If you desire your child to be distanced or remain distanced within a family group, please contact us (info@thrivekg.org) or let us know at check-in.)
- Hand Sanitizer and Hand Wipes: These items will continue to be provided to the kids upon entry to their space and made available in various locations throughout our time together.
- Sanitary Totes: Totes will remain in the spaces for any toys that are used so they can be disinfected at the end of the service.
