Matthew 6:9-13 | “After this manner, pray...”

“Nothing of eternal significance happens without fervent prayer.”

Day 1 – Praise: Worship and Adore Him.

“In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.”

Praise God for who He is ...

- God, You are Supreme Creator, Sovereign King, Thrice Holy God, Righteous Judge, Merciful Savior, Loving Father
- I worship You as Alpha and Omega-The Beginning and the End, El Olam-the Everlasting God (Ps. 90:2)
- I stand in awe of You. You are El Elyon-The Lord Most High (Gen. 14:18-20)
- Jehovah-Jireh – The Lord My Provider (Gen. 22:14) Jehovah-Rapha – The Lord Who Heals (Ex. 15:26).

Jesus, I praise you for who you are...

- The Bread of Life (John 6:35). The Light of the World (John 8:12). The Door of the Sheep (John 10:7).
- The Good Shepherd (John 10:11, 14). The Resurrection and the Life (John 11:25).
- The Way, the Truth, and the Life (John 14:6).

Day 2 - Purpose: God's will be done.

“Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.”

We pray and we long for the full expression of the Kingdom of God

Pray for Kingdom Breakthrough – *In You*

- I long to live more under Your Rule. For You alone are my God and King. Reign in me today.
- Ignite a great passion for You! May I hunger and thirst for righteousness

Pray for Kingdom Breakthrough – *Around You*

- Pray for your FRANS – Friends, Relatives, Associates, and Neighbors to love Jesus more

Pray for Kingdom Breakthrough – *Through You*

- That God would use TFBC to reach Thorsby and beyond with the Gospel of Jesus

Day 3 - Provision: Trust God to meet your needs. Claim His promises.

“Give us this day our daily bread.”

Philippians 4:19 - And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Matthew 6:31-34 - “Therefore do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’³² For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.³³ But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.³⁴ Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble. See Mt. 6:25-34

Psalm 67:1-2 - God be merciful to us and bless us, And cause His face to shine upon us, ***Selah***² That Your way may be known on earth, Your salvation among all nations.

Day 4 - Pardon: Claim cleansing and forgiveness.

“And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”

We Pray for a Personal Forgiveness and a Forgiving Spirit

- **Search Me:** Ps. 139:23-24 - Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.
- **Acknowledge sin:** I John 1:9 - If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- **Forsake sin:** Pr. 28:13 - He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.
- **Release others from sin:** Mt. 6:14-15 - “For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.¹⁵ But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Day 5 - Protection: Thank God for victory over the enemy.

“And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.”

Eph. 6:11-18 - Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

1. Loins girded about with TRUTH
2. Breastplate of RIGHTEOUSNESS
3. Feet shod with the READINESS OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE
4. Shield of FAITH
5. Helmet of SALVATION
6. Sword of the Spirit, which is the WORD OF GOD

I Peter 5:8-10 - Be sober-minded, be alert. Your adversary the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for anyone he can devour. Resist him, firm in the faith, knowing that the same kind of sufferings are being experienced by your fellow believers throughout the world. The God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself, restore, establish, strengthen, and support you after you have suffered a little while.

James 4:7 - Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

I John 4:4 - You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

Day 6 - Praise: Once again worship and adore Him.

“For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.”

1 Chron. 29:10-11 - “Blessed are You, Lord God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever. Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all.

Rev. 4:11 - “You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created.”

Rev. 5:12 - “Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!”
