

## MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES AT FIRST BAPTIST SUMMERFIELD

### Current Opportunities<sup>1</sup>:

~ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANTS (volunteer): Assist the Church Office with bulk mailing projects, filing, folding, printing, etc to allow office staff to maximize their focus on higher priority tasks. This is on an “as needed” basis.

~AUDIO/VIDEO TECHNICIANS: Responsible for mixing/monitoring the audio/video/lighting aspects for all events and services.

~CHILDREN’S MINISTRY: Assist with weekly children’s ministry needs, AWANA teacher, AWANA Bible verse listener, Vacation Bible School, special events, etc.

~COMMUNICATIONS MINISTRY: Assist and/or lead in preparing/creating communications—both digital and print—that First Baptist would be able to use for informational/promotional purposes.

~DISASTER RELIEF: Serve our community, state, and globe through emergency relief in times of disaster. This also includes opportunities to help with simple home repair jobs for the elderly, disabled, etc.

~DISCIPLESHIP: Assist, lead, and/or teach in our Sunday school & small groups ministry offered throughout the year.

~EVANGELISM: Assist and/or lead others in sharing the gospel and spreading the word about upcoming events through evangelism efforts (including praying, phone calls, letter writing, and personal visits).

~EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY: Assist and/or lead in capturing ministry moments via photo that First Baptist would be able to use and share for informational/promotional purposes.

~EVENT VIDEOGRAPHY: Assist and/or lead in capturing ministry moments via video that First Baptist would be able to use and share for informational/promotional purposes.

~FIRST IMPRESSIONS: This team serves as the first impressions of our church to guests, members, and attenders. The First Impressions Team is made up of 4 sub teams – parking, greeters, ushers, and welcome center volunteers.

~HOMELESS MINISTRY: Serve at a local homeless shelter (every 5<sup>th</sup> Wednesday). The team prepares, delivers, serves, and cleans up after the meal. Additionally, they interact, share testimonies, and extend the gospel with those at the shelter.

~KIDS CHOIR: Invest in the next generation through music. Kids choir leaders help elementary age children prepare on a weekly basis for special music events that occur throughout the year involving the kids choir.

~KITCHEN: The kitchen team prepares and serves meals for our church and community. This team is responsible for our Wednesday night meals and other special events.

~MARTHA'S MINISTRY: This team utilizes their gifts of hospitality and service to provide meals to bereaved families at our church. The Martha's Ministry team prepares and serves a meal, to family and friends, following funeral services of members at FBC Summerfield.

~MEDIA SPECIALISTS: Responsible for putting together and/or designing media that can be used for our pre-service slideshows. In addition to this, they are responsible for preparing the song lyrics each week and building the worship presentation in ProPresenter for our services.

~MISSIONS: Participate in short-term missional opportunities around the world that are designed to introduce various aspects of foreign missions and missionaries to members of First Baptist.

~MUSIC: We utilize individual vocalist, worship choirs, and select groups to accomplish our task of engaging the body of Christ in song.

~OUTREACH: This team serves during local outreach projects, i.e., teacher appreciation, back to school events, community events, etc.

~PASTOR'S RESEARCH ASSISTANTS: Research specific areas (as requested by the pastor's) of Biblical, demographic, and community data to compile for use on messages.

~PRAISE BAND: Instrumentalists who play during worship services and special events.

~PRAISE TEAM SINGERS: Singers who use their vocals to lead with excellence during worship services and special events as requested.

~PRAYER: The team that prays for and follows up on specific prayer requests that come through the connection cards.

~PROOFREADERS: Assist with analyzing and improving (Includes editing and formatting) all written and visual communication shared by First Baptist. These individuals display excellence in various areas of communication.

~PUBLICITY: Assist and/or lead in generating creative writing materials and marketing communications, which could include developing graphics for flyers, and promotional materials. In addition to this, assisting/leading in efforts of publicity to inform First Baptist and our community regarding church events, activities, and Bible studies.

~RECREATION: Assist and/or lead in offering a wide variety of team and individual sports activities. The activities are intended to serve as an opportunity for families and individuals in our community to become more familiar with First Baptist.

~SET-UP/TEAR DOWN MINISTRY: Assist in setting up and/or tearing down venues to prepare them for First Baptist ministry events of all kinds. This could involve setting up/tearing down chairs, tables, stage backdrops, decorations, table décor, etc.

~STUDENT MINISTRY: Invest in the next generation of Middle School and High School students by leading them in what it means to walk with Christ. There are various leadership roles necessary to successfully invest in the next generation of students. These leadership roles include small group leaders, Sunday school teachers, game facilitators, café operators, set-up/tear down team, communications director, and more.

~SUNDAY SCHOOL - ELEMENTARY: Assist and/or lead the next generation of K-5<sup>th</sup> graders in Sunday school. This involves a time of games, Bible study, and applications for practical living that are relevant to their phase of life.

~SUNDAY SCHOOL - PRESCHOOL: Assist and/or lead the next generation of preschoolers in learning foundational truths about God that are relevant to this phase of life (newborns-kindergarten).

~SUNDAY SCHOOL - ADULT: Assist and/or lead as a teacher, share leader, or care leader for our adults in our Inside-Out Sunday school ministry.
