**SAY THIS:** 

Wisdom is worth searching for

In the morning this week, as your kid starts their day, send them off with some encouraging words.

Your cue: finish the following statement, "I hope you know . . .

**SAY THIS:** 

Trust God to give you wisdom

This week during a mealtime ask your kids:

"Who is the wisest person you know? What makes
them wise?"

**SAY THIS:** 

Think before you act

At bedtime this week before you pray, say, so this week we discovered that we should think before we act, why do you think that's a good idea? Then share a time in your life with your child where you didn't think before you acted and what the consequences were...

**Week Four : Foolish Heart**

**SAY THIS:** 

Hang out with wise people

As you are driving around, while on the go, let your kid know one thing you like about spending time with them and then ask them, who do you hang out with that you think is wise? Why do you like hanging out with them...

**Week Five : Brand New** 

**Romans 12:2** 

**SAY THIS:** 

Never stop growing in wisdom

At bedtime this week Pray for each other, that God will help you both to grow in wisdom and to make wise choices this week... Maybe share with each other where this week you are going to need God's help with that.
