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Build Your Message - Review

In class 1 we started by reviewing “Build your message Pt 2 (the boxes).” These six boxes help you understand the flow of putting a message together.

These “Build Your Message” documents are simple overviews. They help you grasp the big picture, before getting buried in the details. It’s important that you do grasp the conceptual flow of putting a message together, before diving into the details.
