Sunday September 19	<p>"I have baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." Mark 1:8</p> <p>"Lord, you breathe life into our bodies through your Spirit. May we embrace our identity as your people, your Temple, filled with your Spirit and live accordingly. In your name, Amen."</p> <p>(A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Monday September 20	<p>"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed," Luke 4:18</p> <p>"Lord, your Spirit anoints us to continue your work, proclaiming good news to the poor, liberty to the captives, sight to the blind, and freedom to the oppressed. May we be the conduit through which your Spirit speaks. In your name, amen."</p> <p>(A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Tuesday September 21	<p>"And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you." John 14:16-17</p> <p>"Father, we are filled with your Spirit. We are your people given to bring about your Kingdom on earth as it is in Heaven. Remind us of this holy purpose and equip us to do your work in this world. Wednesday September 22	<p>"But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me." John 15:26</p> <p>"Lord, when our lives reflect you, they bear witness to you. It is evidence that we are filled with your Spirit. Help us to live as your people filled with your Spirit. Amen."</p> <p>(A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Thursday September 23	<p>"Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you." John 16:7</p> <p>"Lord, some days I wish I could walk the coastline with you. I wish that I could sit at your feet like Mary or Peter, and learn from you but, you say that it is better that you leave because you have sent your Spirit to live within us. Thank you, Jesus, for this incredible gift! In your name we pray, Amen."</p> <p>(A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Friday September 24	<p>"And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment," John 16:8</p> <p>"Spirit, you come to stir in us, to convict the world and the worldliness in us. May we walk so closely with Jesus that your Spirit feels comfortable inside of us, that we can clearly hear and recognize His voice when He speaks. Saturday September 25	<p>"...concerning sin, because they do not believe in me,; John 16:9</p> <p>"Spirit, you convict the world of sin through us, your people. Not because we beat people over the head with your Word or because we proudly condemn the world, but because we live as people humbly submitted to the King. Through our selfless love, grace, and mercy, we reflect your love to the world, a love that illuminates our Savior and convicts of our desperate need for one. Thank you, Spirit. Sunday September 26	<p>“...concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer,” John 16:10</p> <p>“Lord, it is through your Spirit that we are able to become transformed, to be made righteous in your sight. Help us to listen to your voice and live as you guide us. Amen.” (A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Monday September 27	<p>“...concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.” John 16:11</p> <p>“King Jesus, the ruler of this world has been judged. When we see the cross and the empty tomb, we are reminded of your coronation as King and how you have overcome this world. Praise your name! Amen.” (A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Tuesday September 28	<p>“When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.” John 16:13</p> <p>“Lord, truth is not what we understand or think or even makes sense to us. Your Word is truth. Your Spirit speaks truth to us if we would but listen. Help us to listen, O Lord. Amen.” (A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Wednesday September 29	<p>“He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you.” John 16:14</p> <p>“Lord, when we quiet our minds, when we focus on you and the Spirit speaks to us, we hear the very voice of God. Help us, Lord Jesus, to take time and space to hear from you. Amen.” (A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Thursday September 30	<p>“All that the Father has is mine; therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.” John 16:15</p> <p>“Lord, you are Father, Son and Spirit working in perfect harmony to bring about your Kingdom. Thank you, Father, that you would use us to spread your love and mercy to a world that, at times, doesn’t even realize it needs it. Thank you that we get to be a conduit, through your Spirit, to do your work in this world. Amen.” (A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Friday October 1	<p>“John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.” Acts 1:5</p> <p>“Lord, John baptized for the forgiveness of sin, but the Spirit baptizes us as those forgiven of sin (due to your payment on our behalf) to be filled with the very presence of the Lord! How blessed are we?! Amen.” (A prayerful reflection on the Holy Spirit)</p>
Saturday October 2	<p>“And I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, ‘John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.’” Acts 11:16</p> <p>“Lord, remind us that we are forgiven in you, that we are filled with the God of the Universe, the Creator of all things!
