

CAMP MARANATHA CAMP PROTOCOLS 2021

As we prepare to open Camp Maranatha this summer:

- **If you feel uneasy sending your child/camper we fully understand and respect your decision.**
- **If you or your child/camper is a high-risk individual with underlying health conditions we respectfully ask that you not attend this year.**

the following protocols will be followed:

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT ALL CAMP MARANATHA COVID GUIDELINES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE. PARENTS AND STAFF WILL BE NOTIFIED IF CHANGES OCCUR PRIOR TO COMING TO CAMP.

1. **COVID STATEMENT:** Covid 19 is highly contagious and is known to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. By attending Camp Maranatha you agree to abide by the procedures established by the Camp to protect attendees and staff, and you voluntarily assume the risk that you, your child and or your family may be exposed to or infected by Covid-19 either at Camp or when you or your child returns home. You agree to assume all the risks of attendance and participation for you, your child and family, and waive any liability against the Camp, its Director's and Staff, the Appalachian Conference IPHC and any other parties.
2. Anyone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19 in the last **14 days cannot** come to Camp
3. Anyone who has been exposed to Covid-19 in the last **14 days cannot** come to Camp
4. Anyone who is symptomatic and has not tested negative may not come to Camp
5. **3-layer masks are highly recommended** but not mandatory. Students and staff will provide their own masks.
6. Additional COVID-19 sanitization measures will be implemented during and in between each camp to include but not limited to the following:
 - Additional hand sanitizing stations throughout the campus
 - Additional sanitization of hard surfaces
 - Additional disinfectant fogging of rooms between camps
7. Masks will be required by all individuals **during check-in, registration and camper drop-off.**
 - Check-in Procedures will include temperature checks and a COVID-19 Questionnaire
 - During the Camp Maranatha Registration process, social distancing measures will be implemented
8. Daily temperature and health checks during camp.
9. When possible meals will be had outdoors under a tent weather permitting. Mealtimes will be staggered to avoid overcrowding when done indoors.
10. **If at any time during Camp Maranatha a camper/staff member has any illness related symptoms to include, but not limited to the following: temperature of 100 or greater, sore throat, body aches, and/or nausea/vomiting, a qualified medical staff will implement the following sickness protocol**
 - **Camper/Staff will be quarantined**
 - **Parents of sick camper will be notified to come pick-up said camper and have them tested.**
 - **Parents of remaining campers within said cabin, will be notified that a sick child/staff was sent home from their child's cabin. It will be at the discretion of the camp and/or notified parents, whether their camper/junior staff will remain at camp.**
 - **Sick Staff members will be required to leave campus and be tested.**
 - **Due to Covid we are subject to reporting to Health Department**
11. Camp Maranatha 2021 will be a closed campus – no visitors will be allowed. If you have an emergency and need to come to the campus when you arrive please remain in your car and call the camp office.
12. We will adopt the following *Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability* section within our COVID-19 protocol to be included in our online camper/staff applications
 - **For those camper/staff applications that have already been submitted, they will be required to complete an online COVID-19 waiver form prior to camp.**

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

I am willingly entering property owned or controlled by Appalachian Conference IPHC ("Camp Maranatha") for the purposes of attending an event (the "Event"). I understand that notwithstanding the preventative efforts of myself and/or others during my attendance at the Event, Appalachian Conference IPHC cannot guarantee that I will not become infected with COVID-19 at the Event or while I am otherwise Appalachian Conference IPHC property.

By signing this agreement, I voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID- 19 by attending the Event and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death (collectively, "Injury"). I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Appalachian Conference IPHC employees, volunteers, and Event participants. I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility should I experience Injury, damage, loss, claims, liability, or expense (collectively, "Losses"), of any kind in connection with my participation in the Event. On my behalf, I hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue, and hold harmless Appalachian Conference IPHC, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from any Losses, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs, or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Losses based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of Appalachian Conference IPHC, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in the Event. To the extent I breach this covenant not to sue, I agree to defend, indemnify, and hold Event harmless from any liability, losses, claims, damages, costs or expenses, including attorneys' fees, arising out of such breach.
