MAIN SCRIPTURE: Exodus 32:1-10 / Исход 32:1-10

1 When the people saw that Moses was so long in coming down from the mountain, they gathered around Aaron and said, "Come, make us Gods who will go before us. As for this fellow Moses who brought us up out of Egypt, we don't know what has happened to him." 2 Aaron answered them, "Take off the gold earrings that your wives, your sons and your daughters are wearing, and bring them to me." 3 So all the people took off their earrings and brought them to Aaron. 4 He took what they handed him and made it into an idol cast in the shape of a calf, fashioning it with a tool. Then they said, "These are your Gods, Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt." 5 When Aaron saw this, he built an altar in front of the calf and announced, "Tomorrow there will be a festival to the LORD." 6 So the next day the people rose early and sacrificed burnt offerings and presented fellowship offerings. Afterward they sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in revelry. 7 Then the LORD said to Moses, "Go down, because your people, whom you brought up out of Egypt, have become corrupt. 8 They have been quick to turn away from what I commanded them and have made themselves an idol cast in the shape of a calf. They have bowed down to it and sacrificed to it and have said, 'These are your Gods, Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt.' 9 "I have seen these people," the LORD said to Moses, "and they are a stiffnecked people. 10 Now leave me alone so that my anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them. Then I will make you into a great nation."

KEY WORDS

- Aaron (AIR n) was Moses' older brother. He served as Moses' spokesman to Pharaoh. In the desert, Aaron made an idol when the people asked for it. Aaron died at age 123.
- The Golden Calf Made by Aaron was an image of a young bull. It was probably made of wood with thin layers of gold covering it. The people gave the gold for the idol. They got it from the Egyptians when they left Egypt.
- A Consequence Is something that happens because of an earlier event.




