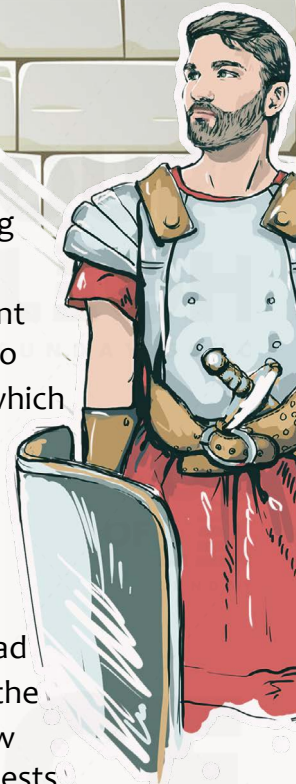


LESSON 7

REWARDS БУДЕТ ЛИ НАГРАДА

MAIN SCRIPTURE: Joshua 3:1-17 / Исус Навин 3:1-17

1 Early in the morning Joshua and all the Israelites set out from Shittim and went to the Jordan, where they camped before crossing over. 2 After three days the officers went throughout the camp, 3 giving orders to the people: “When you see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the Levitical priests carrying it, you are to move out from your positions and follow it. 4 Then you will know which way to go, since you have never been this way before. But keep a distance of about two thousand cubits between you and the ark; do not go near it.” 5 Joshua told the people, “Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the LORD will do amazing things among you.” 6 Joshua said to the priests, “Take up the ark of the covenant and pass on ahead of the people.” So they took it up and went ahead of them... 14 So when the people broke camp to cross the Jordan, the priests carrying the ark of the covenant went ahead of them. 15 Now the Jordan is at flood stage all during harvest. Yet as soon as the priests who carried the ark reached the Jordan and their feet touched the water’s edge, 16 the water from upstream stopped flowing. It piled up in a heap a great distance away, at a town called Adam in the vicinity of Zarethan, while the water flowing down to the Sea of the Arabah (that is, the Dead Sea) was completely cut off. So the people crossed over opposite Jericho. 17 The priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD stopped in the middle of the Jordan and stood on dry ground, while all Israel passed by until the whole nation had completed the crossing on dry ground.

KEY WORDS



• **Right, Righteous** - In the Old Testament, right and righteous usually mean obeying rules or keeping the Law.

• **Just, Justice** - In the Old Testament, just and justice refer to fairness. God desires obedience and fairness more than anything else.

• **Sacrifice** - Proverbs 21:3 refers to something offered in worship.

• **Joshua** - Was one of the spies sent to scout the new land. He was an assistant to Moses. When Moses died, Joshua became the leader of the Hebrew people. Joshua led the people to enter and conquer the land God promised.

• **Jericho** - Is one of the oldest live-in cities in the world. In Bible times, it was an oasis with many palm trees, but it was also a fortress between the Jordan River and the hill country of the new land.

• **Правда, Праведность** - В Ветхом Завете правда и праведность обычно значат быть послушным закону или соблюдать закон.

• **Справедливо, справедливость** - В Ветхом Завете справедливо, справедливость часто отображает честность. Бог заслуживает повиновения и честности больше всего.

• **Жертва** - Притчи 21:23 указывает – что-то пожертвованное в служении.

• **Иисус Навин** - Один из посланных для высматривания новой земли. Был помощником Моисея. После смерти Моисея стал лидером израильского народа. Он ввел народ и завоевал обетованную землю.

• **Иерихон** - Один из самых древних городов. В библейское время он был оазисом с пальмовыми деревьями и был крепостью между рекой Иордан и склонами долины новой земли.

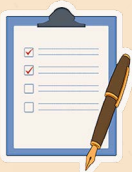

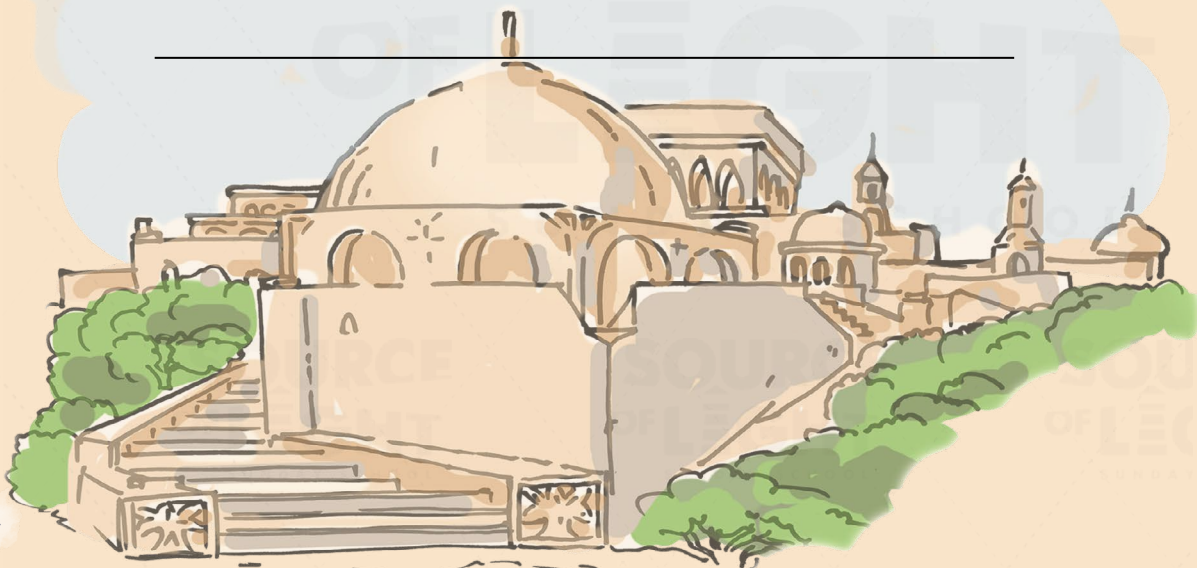
