SB voted & approved the motion to approve Quentin & Allison Mussig & Darlene Herzog for membership.
- II. <u>Emotionally Healthy Discipleship</u> Discussion Chapter 7: Dana led the discussion on "Make Love the Measure of Maturity".

- c. *Financial reports:* Our year end giving was excellent, and a good sign that we are continuing to trend in the direction of bouncing back from COVID. We are on track to meet our 105% budget for 2021-22 budget year. Our current interest rate is 4.5% for our mortgage which will be re-evaluated about 1 year from now.

- VI. Stewardship Team
 - a. Pastor Peter shared his vision for starting a Stewardship Team starting in June. This team would include the Treasurer, Head Trustee, Peter, Caroline, and a couple other lay members (who would be part of it serving 2 year terms).
 - b. This team would coordinate efforts with facilities and finances: deferred maintenance and capital expenditures, debt service recommendations, budget, annual audit, safety & security issues, and keep a pulse on discipleship of our people regarding stewardship.
 - c. This team would handle some work within, but also would make recommendations to the SB. Scope of the team's decision-making vs recommendations will need to be clarified & communicated.
 - d. This team would meet on the 2nd Monday of the month as well, but they will meet at 4:30 or 5pm, and then there will be a crossover with the SB of dinner and the discipleship lesson.

e. Guy made a motion; Dana seconded motion to approve a Stewardship Team to be put in place. The SB voted and approved the motion.

b. Adult Sunday School

a. Wayne Worthley has approached us about starting up an Adult Sunday School class again. Pastors Steve & Peter shared conversations they had with Wayne. Potential names: Foundations Plus, Bible Study. We agreed to move forward with this class option. Pastors Steve & Peter will continue to work with Wayne to initiate this option on Sunday mornings. Proposed time: 10:45am Sunday mornings.

c. District Merger

a. At our Annual District Conference this summer, we will be voting on merging with the Northwest District of the Wesleyan Church. Pastor Peter spoke positively of this move & its advantage & value of cross-pollinating with other churches especially those with multiple staffs (i.e. Worship Directors, Kids' Pastors).

d. Current Sunday morning Schedule

- a. We will discuss this more at the March Meeting, but Pastor Peter would like us to start thinking about our Sunday morning schedule.
 - 1. How are people responding to the livestreaming at the 9am services? Consensus is that it's been positive and well-received.
 - 2. We still have around 40 households online every week. Is there a point where we might consider pulling the plug on doing a livestream? Here are a few resources making the case to do just that. For now, continue to keep a pulse on this as COVID infection rates decrease. The SB requested that info be pulled to asses if folks are watching online locally or outside the Cedar Valley area.
