SMALL GROUP GUIDE

Jesus taught us to celebrate the Lord's Supper in "remembrance of me". This remembering (or reminding) has 3 senses:

1. Past: it reminds us of what Jesus did.

2. Present: it reminds us of what Jesus is doing.

3. Future: it reminds us of what Jesus will do.

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1. WELCOME

If anyone has had a significant event in their life this past week, give them a minute to share with the group. If necessary, take some time to pray for any immediate needs right at the beginning of the meeting.

2. VISION/PURPOSE

Next Sunday, August 23rd 9:45 we will have one outdoor service at Trinity followed by a groundbreaking ceremony. We want to promote unity and togetherness after a difficult season, so please come if you feel comfortable doing so.

3. SMALL GROUP GUIDELINES

Review guidelines (Use "I" Statements, No Fixing, Confidentiality, Listening) that cultivate a healthy environment for sharing and discussion.

5. READ SCRIPTURE PASSAGE/TELL BIBLE STORY PASSAGE

6. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Use a good mix of Head (informational/study) questions, Heart (personal reflection) questions, and Hand (practical application) questions. Below are questions your group can pick from to follow along with the sermon series.

7. PERSONAL SHARING AND PRAYER REQUESTS

You can share and pray in one group, in smaller groups, or in gender specific groups. Make sure that phone numbers are shared so that encouragement and connection can happen during the week.

QUESTIONS

WARM UP: *Share about a family tradition that is meaningful to you? [Jesus gave His family the tradition of celebrating the Lord's Supper, but many are confused about this tradition. Let's get into God's Word together.]*

HEAD: These questions help us examine the Word.

1. Read Luke 22:1-21. Why did Jesus desire to celebrate the Passover with them? What was He trying to communicate?
2. Why would God require the shedding of blood to atone for sin?
3. Read 1 Jesus taught us to celebrate the Lord's Supper in "remembrance of me". How is this kind of remembrance different than how we typically remember things?
4. There are 3 senses of remembering here: past, present and future. Why is it so important for us to remember Jesus in all 3 of these ways?

HEART: These questions help us wrestle with what we believe.

5. Which of the 3 senses of remembering comes the most naturally? Which one challenges you the most?
6. How will you treat the Lord's Supper differently after this teaching?

HAND: These questions help us bring truth and beliefs into our everyday life.

7. Read Matthew 5:21-23. How might this apply to the Lord's Supper? Is there someone need to reconcile with?
