Pastor's Page

I must confess, I never thought I'd write a church newsletter article for the month of Easter that included a worship schedule for online worship only on Easter Sunday. But, sadly, that is the case this year in the midst of the Covid-19 pandemic. You've heard me say (or seen me write) several times over the past couple of weeks that we should let the empty building remind us that the tomb is empty as well. In other words, regardless of our present circumstances, Christ is still Risen! He is Risen, indeed!

The empty tomb reminds us that things are never as bleak as they might seem on the surface. Yes, these are difficult times in which we're living. But this is not the end of the story. We might not know exactly what chapters are still to unfold, but we certainly know how the story ends. It ends with Victory! Victory in Jesus! Rather than dwelling on the things we don't have this year (like public worship on Easter), let's focus instead on what we do have. We have the love of God from which we can never be separated if we remain in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Sure, life has given us lemons for a season; so let's make lemonade! Let's be like the prophet Joel and declare a holy fast in the midst of a famine. Let's show the world how much we love God during this difficult season. Even more, let's show the world how much God loves us – all of us – each and every one of us!

To be perfectly honest, I think this whole Covid-19 thing has awakened a sleeping giant. The Church, all across the world, has often been guilty of simply going through the motions. Sometimes it feels like we've been asleep at the switch. I'm not saying the church hasn't been busy and that it hasn't been doing some really good things. I'm just saying I'm seeing a lot more effort going into finding ways to make personal connections with people, even if not in person. People are rediscovering the lost art of sending cards and letters. They are talking on the phone rather than just sending texts. They are more concerned with caring for the vulnerable than satisfying their own desires. I think we're seeing the gospel play out in everyday life more than many (most) of us have ever seen before. Praise God for that!

I've heard many people compare this time to the plagues against Egypt in the Old Testament and others see this as a sign of the end times. I'm not sure about all that and I really don't spend much time thinking about it. Jesus was clear that the day and the hour are unknown (Matthew 24:36), and I'm content with that. However, if the lake turns to blood and we are overrun with frogs, I may reconsider the Egypt thing. But seriously, I actually see other parts of Scripture more prevalently in these times. I see Romans 8:28 in all of this. I see God working through it to bring forth something good. I see Genesis 50:20 in all of this. That's the verse where Joseph says to his brothers who sold him into slavery, "You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives."

I'm sure the devil thinks he's winning right now with this awful virus (just like he did at the cross). But I think God is using it to awaken his sleeping giant. I think God is working through this to accomplish something good – the saving of many lives for all eternity. So don't be deceived. Things are not always as they appear. God is doing a mighty work here. Let's get on board and do our part. Let's show the world what it looks like to "be not afraid." Let's show the world Victory in Jesus!



Appalachia Service Project

Jr. High and Middle School ASP-June 28-July 4, 2020

ASP (Appalachia Service Project) has opened the Summer ministry to those who have finished 6th, 7th, 8th or 9th grade. This year the Jr. High trip will be in Jonesville, Virginia at the year-round center owned and operated by ASP. We will leave on Sunday morning, June 28 and return on Saturday afternoon, July 4, 2020.

On Monday, there will be training sessions, and Tuesday through Friday, we will work on a project. ASP has prepared age-appropriate service projects, along with extensive programming, to educate our students about volunteerism, Appalachian regional issues, and the Appalachia Service Project. Similar to the current Summer Home Repair Program, students and their adult leaders will still participate in hands-on home repairs and community projects, with additional, detailed training on the tools and projects they will be working with that week. Each evening, Youth will engage in educational and reflective programming, as well as daily worship. This program will put a heavy emphasis on helping students connect their experiences that week with a wider understanding of what it means to live a life of service.

The cost is \$175.00 per person, and we will have fundraisers to help with the cost if needed. This January, Matt & Beth were blessed to adopt a Short Hair German Pointer/Beagle named Tolin. Tolin had been in training as a service dog for a marine veteran, but that match was not able to happen. Tolin has received eight months of training, and her trainer is confident she would have qualified as a service dog. When the match fell through, they chose to adopt her to a family who worked with children who were looking for a therapy dog. We had a friend who told us about Tolin and God just made it all happen. Tolin has been to church a few times on Wednesday nights and Sunday mornings. Her job is to be a sense of peace and calmness for people. Research has shown that the act of petting an animal lowers blood pressure and stress

hormones. We have seen Tolin have an impact on kids when she is here and has helped them to calm down and refocus. Dogs have this innate ability to love unlike anything else. This Summer, Tolin will be certified as a therapy dog, and that will open the door to being able to take her into the schools, nursing homes, hospitals, funeral homes, the Library, and other places that are all looking for pet therapy. Tolin is not a service dog, and her job is to show God's love in a unique way. So when you see her at the church, all are welcome to come up and say, "hi." She loves to be petted on her back and fetch is her love language.
