GUIDELINES FOR YOUTH MINISTRY ACTIVITIES:

The following guidelines are not to restrict or to confine students, but serve as a way we can closely ensure the safety of the participants. If these guidelines are violated by students certain consequences will result. These consequences will be defined on a case by case basis and may require parental involvement. These guidelines are summarized by just one simple rule - **Students: use common sense in every decision and action.**

- Be encouraging and respectful of all participants in an event/activity. Remember our goal is to build people up, not tear them down.
- 2. No one under age 21 is allowed to drive a vehicle during a youth event.
- 3. All students/participants must display respect and obedience to our staff and volunteer advisors.
- All our events/activities are substance free. Possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products, or other mood altering substance is strictly prohibited. Only prescribed medications are allowed.
- **5.** Think of everything you do and say as work on God's behalf. Act and speak accordingly.
