## **GOD'S WORD TO THE WEARY**

*(Jeremiah 45:1-5)*

### **INTRODUCTION:**

*"The Lord GOD has given Me the tongue of disciples,  
That I may know how to sustain the weary one with a word."*

*—Isaiah 50:4*

*"For I satisfy the weary ones and refresh everyone who languishes."*

*—Jeremiah 31:25*

### **1A. THE CONTEXT: (v. 1-2)**

*"This is the message which Jeremiah the prophet spoke to Baruch the son of Neriah, when he had written down these words in a book at Jeremiah's dictation, in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah, saying: <sup>2</sup>Thus says the LORD the God of Israel to you, O Baruch..."*

### **2A. THE COMPLAINT: (v. 3)**

*"You said, 'Ah, woe is me! For the LORD has added sorrow to my pain; I am weary with my groaning and have found no rest.'"*

### 3A. THE COUNSEL: (v. 4-5)

*"Thus you are to say to him, 'Thus says the LORD, "Behold, what I have built I am about to tear down, and what I have planted I am about to uproot, that is, the whole land."'<sup>5</sup> 'But you, are you seeking great things for yourself? Do not seek them; for behold, I am going to bring disaster on all flesh,' declares the LORD, 'but I will give your life to you as booty in all the places where you may go.'"*
