(Titus 2:1-10)

**INTRODUCTION:**

**PREVIOUSLY: CONFIRMING ELDERS:**

1. Take a Look at His home. Tell me about his family. (v. 6)
2. Take a Look at His heart. Tell me about his fruitfulness. (v. 7-8)
3. Take a Look at His handling of the Word. Tell me about his faithfulness. (v. 9)

**PREVIOUSLY: CONFRONTING ERROR:**

1. The faith must be firmly held in the face of uncertainty.
2. The faith must be fiercely defended in the face of attack.
3. The faith must be fervently proclaimed in the face of rejection.
4. The faith must be faithfully lived in the face of corruption.
