Robert Graham formerly taught trombone at UVA and was a co-founder of Mr. Jefferson's Bones, a trombone quartet in central Virginia. After the Charlottesville riots, Robert thought that it might be beneficial for the people of Charlottesville to have the direct experience of resonance in the space that had so recently experienced so much dissonance.
