## Park County Republican Assembly Results

First off, I want to thank each of you for your patience and understanding during this difficult week. Your Executive Board was working feverishly to get this necessary process accomplished before facing any further restrictions. Turnout today was excellent and working together we got the job done.

The tally procedure was accomplished in such a fashion that no one on the Teller Committee was able to associate a ballot with a name. After confirming unopened envelopes by the number of delegates per precinct, and then elevating alternates as needed, the envelopes were shuffled and placed face down at one end of a table. We had 110 total envelopes accepted. I opened each envelope and spilled the contents out to the middle of the table, keeping the face of the envelope away from the Tellers. They sorted the various ballots into piles by race. Once all envelopes had been opened and discarded, the Tellers began counting the votes.

**Commissioner District 1:** Out of 103 votes cast, Steve Vincze garnered 45 votes and Katie Spodyak had 36 votes, both acquiring more than 30% and are therefore placed on the primary ballot based on vote totals. Garrison Genschorck had 22 votes, which places him between 10% and 30% and is therefore on the ballot as a result of his petition signatures.

**Commissioner District 2:** Richard Elsner acquired 80 votes out of 85 cast, which is greater than 30% and is therefore placed on the ballot.

The Vacancy Committee was approved. The Precinct Committee Persons nominated at the caucuses were ratified.

**Congressional District 2 (parts of Bailey):** All eight delegates were accepted.
