Summary

A Videographer works closely with the Technical Director and operates video cameras and related equipment in the production of the live broadcast of Sunday services and events, video documentaries, or other video productions.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Operates video equipment in the production of live or pre-recorded content
- Know and apply the technical aspects of lenses, filters, film, light, and camera settings to each shot to ensure the Technical Director gets the effect that he or she wants
- Watches film closely to determine if problems are present in regards to camera angles or lighting to notify the Technical Director before filming starts
- Maintains, cleans, and tests all cameras and broadcast equipment to ensure it is in good working order before and after filming

Skills Needed

- Open to Constructive Feedback
- Time Management
- Problem Solving
- Attention to Detail
- Critical Thinking

Physical Requirements

While performing these duties, the Videographer is required to frequently communicate with the Technical Director, Ministry Leaders, Volunteers, and Elders. Must be able to exchange information accurately. The Videographer may occasionally move various equipment weighing up to 50lbs for performances and event needs.
