- **1. Passionate Worshiping Christians** who gather together regularly at our worship services to give God His due by praying, praising, and hearing His proclaimed Word. We've summarized this concept with the phrase **LOVE GOD**.
- **2. Connected Christians** who unite over God's Word and with other Christians in real life-on-life community. The way we do this at COS is through our Community Groups—small groups that focus on Jesus, His Word, and spiritually invigorating relationships. We've briefly stated this concept in the phrase **LOVE OTHERS**.
- **3. Energized Christians** who impact their spheres of influence by God's empowering presence which flows through humble, dependent, and obedient followers of Christ using their spiritual gifts to transform the world to His glory! This concept is captured in our phrase **SERVE THE WOLRD**.

God has blessed Church of the Saviour with a wealth of resources (treasure, time, and talents). Thank you to all who so generously gave to global outreach through Giving Tuesday. Even as COS has taken the first steps towards renewing our mission's strategy, it's important to remember that we still have almost sixty global and local partners that are being supported through the generosity of this congregation. You will see from the financial update on the last page of this newsletter, missions giving is significantly below what is needed and will not allow us to sustain the current levels of support beyond just a few months. The Giving Tuesday total giving from this time last year was \$51,645 The Giving Tuesday total YTD for this year is significantly lower and has come in at \$17,980.

CR has helped me to be in recovery from Co-Dependency. It has given me the freedom from enabling and being in constant struggle from worry and trying to fix another's addiction. My burden/sin of anxiety and desire for control is healed as I share openly my struggles with other broken and honest sisters. I've realized that keeping these hurts, hang-ups, and habits to myself make these burdens heavier and heavier but God knew that sharing and bringing them out, lightens the burden for myself and others. CELEBRATE RECOVERY

I struggled with food, fear, lack of trust, insecurity, feelings of unworthiness. I tried spiritual means with other believers, but my struggles persisted for over 6 decades until God led me to the original 12 Step program of recovery in 2018. Hearned I was not only physically and mentally ill, but I was also spiritually sick, and only a Power greater than myself could help me. By God's grace and mercy, and through working the steps, I recommitted my life to Jesus Christ. He then led me to COS and to Celebrate Recovery. In little more than a year of working in the CR program, I have experienced a deeper transformation in my heart and mind, a deeper connection with my Higher Power, Jesus Christ, a better relationship with myself and others, and a desire to share my message of recovery with others who have similar struggles. COMMUNICATING ACCROSS CULTURES

Don't miss Intercultural Communications Training Part 1 & 2 coming up on January 22 & 29 with our own Dr. Rudie Altamirano.

PART 1:

January 22, 2022, 8:30-12:00 p.m. Fellowship Hall. (Continental Breakfast will be available.) Register <u>HERE</u>.

Intercultural communication plays an important role in the Church of the Saviour's vibrant community of people from all over the world and all walks of life. Whether it's in the classroom, in the office, socially or professionally, and even in church settings communication across cultures can be a source of conflict but can also be a window to another point of view. It can also impact the successful sharing of the gospel and meeting the Great Commission. In this first track, you will gain an understanding of cultural factors that are involved in interactions and ideas of low and high-context communication so that you can enhance your relationships with others. There are many facets of life that have an impact on how we communicate with others. Your home culture - whether it be a country, region, or down to the scope of your family - all influences how we communicate and can impact your relationships with others. Life experiences and identities also differ from one person to the next. This session will grow your awareness of facts that impact intercultural communication, help you become a more effective communicator, and support our shared goal to create a safer, more inclusive environment at Church of the Saviour.

COMMUNICATING ACCROSS CULTURES

PART 2:

Are you a direct or indirect communicator? Do you take a more attached or detached approach? There are many ways to communicate, and sometimes different styles can intersect and clash. In this track, you'll learn different communication styles and analyze scenarios where different communication styles are in play. Participants will be directly involved in exploring and discussing ways to manage intercultural conflicts. Participants will engage in a presentation, discussion, and role-play scenarios about culture, values, perceptions, communication styles, and cultural patterns of thought and behavior that will help them understand the important concepts, theories, and issues of intercultural communication related to intercultural conflicts and how these concepts apply to your personal, professional and spiritual lives. When people from different cultures interact, miscommunication and misunderstanding are inevitable. The session's aim is to discuss cultural norms, expectations, and behaviors as well as to identify how best to minimize potential conflicts in order to improve intercultural communication. This is intended for those who have attended our PART 1 Communication Across Cultures workshop or possess some knowledge or experience dealing with individuals from different cultures or overseas travel.

ALPHA

While many of us are gearing up for the Christmas season, "Who can I invite to ALPHA in January?" may not be at the forefront of our minds. But shortly after the new year, ALPHA's winter session will begin on Tuesday, Jan. 11 with a kick-off Sunday on Jan. 9.

The holiday season is a great time to invite a friend or family member to ALPHA. Many people are more open to spiritual discussions than any other time of year - they're more likely to attend an Advent worship service or a Christmas concert, too! Use your Luke 11:2 card to pray at 11 a.m. and/or 11 p.m. each day over whom you might invite to ALPHA (we have more if you need them).

Here is a brief description of each program we're offering next semester to help you decide which one is right for you and those you may invite:

- **ALPHA** (in-person and virtual options): a series of talks discussing different questions about the Christian faith, designed to create conversation.
- ALPHA Marriage (virtual only): See article below.
- **ALPHA Pre-Marriage** (virtual only): For engaged couples or those exploring marriage to build a strong foundation for a lasting relationship.

ALPHA MARRIAGE

Anyone who has been married for longer than 5 minutes can tell you that relationships, especially within a marriage, can be complicated. This is why we are big fans of the ALPHA Marriage Course.

ALPHA Marriage is part of the ALPHA family of ministries with a focus on strengthening marriages. The course is designed for all married couples, no matter the health of your relationship or how long you've been married.

The course consists of 7 marriage-related topics presented as interactive videos that combine teaching, storytelling, and reflection questions. Lesson content is grounded in biblical principles and perspectives on marriage, but it is designed to help couples with a wide range of spiritual backgrounds.

Each week, the group meets on Zoom for a quick introduction to go over some highlights for that night's topic. Couples then watch the videos on their own and work through the exercises together at home to allow for privacy.

This semester, ALPHA Marriage begins on Tuesday, January 11, and will run for 9 weeks on Tuesday evenings. You can learn more about Alpha Marriage or signup at coswayne.org/alphamarriage.
