- 12- Jesus spoke to Thomas and said, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." (John 20:27)
- 13- This time, Thomas believed and revered God. He said, "My Lord and my God!" (John 20:28)
- 14- Jesus told Thomas, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." (John 20:29)


