

1. Coming back to the building for services may not necessarily be what is best for you right now. While we are taking measures to mitigate risks related to COVID-19, we cannot eliminate risk altogether. Thus, if you, or others you will be around are at a higher risk for COVID-19 it might be best for you to continuing streaming our services online. We will continue our live broadcasts of services indefinitely, so you can always tune in with us from anywhere - not just by being in the building. *Also, if you are experiencing any COVID-19 related symptoms, please DO NOT come to the building for services.*

2. We will only have special children's and youth programming during our 10:30am services. We are slowly and safely re-introducing a number of children's and youth ministry elements back into Sunday mornings. 3. Out of love for neighbor and community we do ask that you practice social distancing (6 feet) while in the building, and wear a face mask while on site. In an effort to stay in step with our community (and potentially slowing the spread of the virus), we are voluntarily embracing the mask mandate put forward by Governor Walz on July 25th. Masks will be available on site each week for anyone who would like or need one.
