

As most of our church family knows by now, 2021 ended painfully for my family. After a period of household quarantining over Christmas Eve, we learned that my father passed away after five months at home under hospice care. I'm pleased to share that we are doing well, including my mother who is moving forward with grace and dignity. I've enjoyed reflecting on my dad's life with fondness and appreciating the many good times we had and qualities I admired in him. The journey has been healing, and I look forward to seeing him again in our eternal home. I also want to thank you for the outpouring of love you've shown my family and me during this time.

Something to Celebrate


I also want to thank you for your outstanding financial generosity in December! I had estimated that we would need about \$150,000 of December offerings to finish 2021 with our yearly income exceeding our expenses. Well, we didn't reach that numeric goal – finishing with an income of \$143,509. However, God knew *exactly* what we needed, and we not only made up for our spending deficit heading into November but ended the year with excess general budget income of \$1,585! Our strong December also means that we were able to give away \$9,674 to each of our mission projects – Haiti Relief and support for *A Call for Help*. I praise God for his faithfulness working through your generosity!

Moving Forward in 2022

As I write this, we just ended another successful "Connect Lunch" with several newer families in attendance (several of whom began attending online). A question was raised, "What is the church's theme for 2022?" I chuckled because I never publicly identify a yearly theme or focus. However, I did respond with the emphasis that God has placed on my heart. If we were to have a theme for 2022, it would be "to dig deeper into God's Word and make disciples who make disciples." I hope you are experiencing rich blessing from our first few weeks in the book of Mark. We will continue this journey through Easter before kicking off another exciting dive into the Scriptures together. And over the next month, dozens of us will launch intentional discipleship training bands as we seek to cultivate a deeper intimacy with God and prepare ourselves for leading others through this discipleship journey. Our "Launch Party" will take place on Sunday, February 6th at noon in the Family Life Center. You can read more about it in this newsletter. Spring 2022 Journey Groups start back up in the New Year! Welcome to the spring semester!

Journey Groups offer a safe environment for growing Christ-followers to experience spiritual growth, relational support and lasting life change! There is a variety of topic options as well as range of locations and times to best fit your interest and schedule. Please take some time to review all the choices and join the Journey Group that's best for you.

Spring 2022 Journey Group FAQ's

What is an adult Journey Group?

Journey groups are made up of people who meet on a regular basis to connect relationally, grow spiritually, and serve collectively with one another.

What kind of Journey Groups are available?

There are different types of Journey Groups; Ongoing Journey Groups who meet year-round, ongoing Journey Groups that meet during the fall and spring semesters, and short-term Journey Groups who meet the duration of a specific study. At the end of each session, you will have the choice of staying in the same group, trying a new group or even taking a break.

Why should I join a Journey Group?

We were designed by God to live in relationship with others. Positive life-change happens best when we are surrounded by friends who support, encourage, and challenge us. Journey Groups will help you feel like you belong in the Troy UMC family.

Who can attend?

Everyone! Members, attenders, Christ-followers, and spiritual seekers! Most of our groups are mixed groups (open to men, women, married and single). We also have groups that are specific to men, women, or young adults.

What happens in a group?

In Journey Groups we build lasting friendships through a commitment to being 1) God-centered through some form of Bible study, 2) Authentic through sharing of the joys and concerns of life, and 3) Inclusive by welcoming everyone seeking godly community. Groups will often eat together, pray together and simply do life together.

Will I feel intimidated by my lack of Biblical knowledge?

Not at all! Our Journey Groups are designed to be a safe place for people who are taking steps to deepen their knowledge of God's Word. You can ask questions, share your opinions and experiences, or just listen to others share.




