

**Genesis 40 Days of Prayer, Week #7**  
**We pray for MULTIPLICATION**

Sunday Introduction (3/28): ***We come with hope***

Matthew 17:20 - 20 He replied, "Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

Day 35: Monday, March 29

**Pray for opportunities for you to share the joy of Easter**

\* Matthew 28: 8 So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples. Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings," he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him. Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers..."

Day 36: Tuesday, March 30

**Pray for your church as they prepare to celebrate Easter... pray for people to invite to "come and see."**

\* John 1:37-42 The two followers heard what John said, so they went after Jesus. Jesus turned. He saw them coming after him. He said to them, "What are you looking for?"

They said, "Teacher, where do you live?"

Jesus said, "Come and see." They went and saw the place where Jesus was staying. The time was about four o'clock in the afternoon. They stayed with Jesus the rest of the day.

Andrew was one of those two followers of John who heard John speak and went after Jesus. He was Simon Peter's brother. The first thing Andrew did then was to find his brother Simon. He said, "We have found the Messiah!" (Messiah means the Christ, the messenger of God.) Andrew brought Simon to Jesus.

Day 37: Wednesday, March 31

**Pray that your church would be fruitful and multiply**

\* John 15:5, 7-8 "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing..."

If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

Day 38: Thursday, April 1

**Pray for Genesis, that we would "be fruitful and multiply"**

\* Philippians 1:3-6 I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Day 39: Friday, April 2

**Pray for the FMC, the Bishops, and our worldwide church**

\* Matthew 28:18-20 - Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Day 40: Saturday, April 3

**We close in a prayer of thanks, praise, and asking that He would be powerfully at work in and among us**

***Ephesians 3: 20-21 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.***
