POSSIBLE STAGES OF RE-GATHERING

As Christians and a body of believers, we are called to honor those in authority. Based on the State of Washington's four-phase plan, Malone Assembly has made plans and prepared for what the next few months may look like. The following guidelines were used:

- We will make decisions with empathy, grace and wisdom
- The health and safety of all in our church and community
- How can we best advance the gospel and not diminish our witness
- Things will be different and we will lead compassionately and boldly
- Flexibility: Plans are important, and will remain fluid as things will change
- Respect: what works for one ministry within our church may not work for another

Phases

Since the phases of reopening are estimated a minimum of 3 weeks for each, we will estimate for each phase as the timeline can change.

During all Phases

We will first seek God's direction, follow the recommendations of the CDC, county health department, and NWMN leadership during all phases to ensure the safety and health of all.

Phase Two: May 22nd

Gather with 5 people (Currently in effect)

- Gatherings – online gatherings will continue
- Malone Youth – Zoom group meetings on Wednesday evenings

Phase Three: Mid/Late June

Gather with 50 or fewer people

- Gatherings – Online gatherings will continue and be primary.
- Home churches – specific homes will be set up for online church and people to gather together in multiple locations in our community
- Malone Kids – No kids ministry during this time
- Malone Youth – we will begin in-person groups

Phase 4: We will communicate more information as we approach **Phase 4.**
