Where Can I Serve At C4? (Check all ministries that interest you.)

- Children's Ministry** – Serve and love the children of C4 through teaching and/or assisting in Children's Ministry. Classrooms include Infants, Walkers (18 months – 3.5 years), Preschoolers (3.5 years to Pre-K), and Elementary (K-5th). Awesome biblical curriculum is used for Walkers, Preschool, and Elementary, so classroom planning is made easy for Bible teaching, crafts, and games. Ministry leader: Auburn Slavec
- Media and Tech Ministry** – Broaden C4's reach beyond our walls by using your technical and operational skills at home by helping maintain functioning technology platforms and uploading consistent and fresh content across C4's media platforms including website, app, social media pages (Facebook, Twitter), GraceFM, YouTube, Livestream, etc... Or use your creative side and create slides, flyers, videos, infographics, website banners, signage, and other formats as needed. Ministry leader: Matt Korniotos
- Sound Booth Ministry** – Ensure excellent sound and technology performance during services and special events by managing projection of worship lyrics and announcements, running all video screens and all onsite AV needs, and supervising live streaming and recording of teachings. Ministry leader: Scott Brown
- Greeting Ministry** – Welcome people as they arrive for service by loving, serving, and encouraging the C4 church body, especially newcomers. As newcomers arrive, be intentional with remembering names and introducing them to the people of C4 and the facility (Children's Ministry, coffee/donuts, restrooms) as well as answering questions. Ministry leader: Lindsey Pintar
- Usher Ministry** – As people arrive for service, help them find seats and welcome them with a warm, loving smile. Help restock donuts and coffee in between services. Ministry leader: Dave Ragan
- Worship Ministry** – Disciple the church in real and spiritual worship as you lead the congregation into the presence of the Lord through music. Worship practice is the first three Thursdays of every month starting at 6pm. Ministry leader: Matt Wallenburg
- Security** – Protect the church body during church services and special events. Ministry leader: Tim Wallenburg
- Parent's Night Out** – Serve parents at C4 by giving them some time away from their kids as you love and serve their children during Parent's Night Out (PNO). PNO is once a month on a Friday night. Servants sign up for 2-3 nights per year. Ministry leader: Lezli Urlacher

- Youth Discipleship** – Create and facilitate discipleship-based lessons for students in 4th-7th grade. This is an alternative ministry for this age group to create a “bridge” from the Children’s Ministry to AMPED Youth Group. Leaders rotate through multi-week sessions. Held during 1st service on Sundays after worship. Ministry leader: Ben Young

- Youth Worship Team** – Children have the same Holy Spirit adults do! The Youth Worship Team is primarily students in grades 6-12 who have a heart to lead children in worship. No experience is necessary – only a heart to be teachable and humble. Adults are also welcome to join the rotation of helping facilitate worship and teach the youth how to play various instruments. Ministry leader: Nikki Hardwick

- AMPED Youth Group** – As youth face all kinds of challenges, have difficult situations and questions, and are often at a turning point in their faith, they need a consistent group of believers with whom they can find support and fellowship. Serving in AMPED is all about pointing middle school and high school kids to Jesus, coming alongside them as they seek a growing relationship with Him, and rejoicing when they come alive in Jesus! Ministry leader: Brian Muhlhauser

- AMPED Youth Worship Team** – This ministry provides music-minded students the opportunity to grow in their walk with Christ and lead worship for AMPED. This is achieved through weekly Bible study, discipleship, prayer, practice, and serving others. No music experience necessary. Open to students in 6-12 grade who have an approved ministry application and are willing to commit to team requirements. Ministry leader: Brian Muhlhauser

- Most Excellent Way** – Come alongside those who are wanting to be free from addiction as they discover that the only true freedom is found in Jesus. They meet weekly on Thursdays at 7pm for a time of Bible study, prayer, discipleship, and fellowship. Ministry leader: Dave Ragan

- Events Ministry** – Throughout the year, we host outreach events and need servants to help! Sign-up to serve occurs on an as-needed basis. Special events include, but are not limited to: Fall Festival, Easter BBQ, VBS, Family Bible Blast, etc... Ministry leader: April Korniotos

- Assisted Living Ministry** – Bless those who are in assisted living homes by teaching, leading worship, or just praying and ministering to the residents as you build ongoing relationships with them each week of providing church services to them. Ministry leader: James Stroud

- Prayer Team** (no ministry app required) – We should ALL be on this team! Ephesians 6:18 says we should be *“praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.”* You can join the Prayer Team email list in lifting up the many needs of those within C4. Emails are sent out periodically with various needs to pray for, and we also meet monthly on the fourth Tuesday for a powerful time of prayer during Prayer Night. Ministry leader: Chin Onwuegbu

- Cleaning Ministry** (no ministry app required) – Clean the church facility on Tuesdays or Saturdays. All cleaning supplies and tasks are clearly outlined at the church. The Tuesday cleaning team cleans weekly. The Saturday cleaning schedule is assigned via Planning Center, and people serve once every 4-6 weeks. Ministry leader: April Korniotos (Tuesdays) and Chin Onwuegbu (Saturdays)

- Meal Ministry** (no ministry app required) – Serve your church family practically by giving them a meal after childbirth, surgery, or the passing of a loved one. You can cook a meal or have a meal delivered. Sign up on an as-needed basis via a Meal Train email. Ministry leader: April Korniotos

- Visitation Ministry** (no ministry app required) – *“For I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.’ ... And the King will answer and say to them, ‘Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.’”* (Matthew 25:35,40) Show the love of Jesus to those who are hospitalized, sick, and homebound by stopping in for a visit. Ministry leader: Chin Onwuegbu

- C4 Movers** (no ministry app required) – This is a super practical way to be the body of Christ in action. On an as-needed basis, C4 Movers will assist people in the congregation with moving (packing and unpacking a moving truck). Ministry leader: Scott Brown

- Pantry** (no ministry app required) – Help keep the food pantry and refrigerator organized by routinely checking expiration dates, keeping items clean and tidy, and making note of needs. Ministry leader: April Korniotos

- Ride Ministry** (no ministry app required) – Join the rotation of serving by giving rides to those who are unable to drive themselves to church services. Ministry leader: Matt Morgan
