HOW TO START A VIRTUAL GROUP

To start a virtual group, simply invite a handful of people to join you on a video call to discuss the sermon together. We recommend Zoom to host these meetings, however you can use whichever video software you like! You will need your members' email addresses or phone numbers to send the link to. Other options for correspondence are Facebook and GroupMe. From there, you need to choose a time that works best for everybody in your group and schedule your first meeting!

HOW SHOULD I FACILITATE THE MEETING?

Video calls are a little trickier to manage than meeting in person, but a few tips can make it easier. We have found that having folks raise their hand before speaking can allow conversation to flow without interruptions. As a group you can work through the discussion questions provided at the end of each sermon to help guide you through your time together.
