HOW TO START A DISCIPLESHIP GROUP

Starting a Discipleship Group is very similar to starting a Home Gathering. It simply takes inviting people to reflect on the sermon and pray for one another. The major difference between Home Gatherings and Discipleship Groups is that Discipleship Groups are made of 2-10 guys or 2-10 girls. Because they are split by gender, there is no need for childcare. The other difference is the way the meetings are held. Folks in Discipleship Groups will watch the sermon prior to the meeting, allowing more time for discussion and prayer. This is similar to how we organize our Small Group meetings.

WHERE SHOULD MY DISCIPLESHIP GROUP MEET?

Because you don't need access to a T.V. for your meeting, your group can meet anywhere in the city. You could meet at a coffee shop or a restaurant on your lunch break. If you don't feel comfortable gathering indoors, you could meet at a park, or in your backyard.
