

Title: 20/20 The Year of a New Chapter, New Beginning, New Destinations

Main Text: Psalm 118:14–21 (NKJV) ¹⁴The LORD *is* my strength and song, And He has become my salvation. ¹⁵The voice of rejoicing and salvation *is* in the tents of the righteous; The right hand of the LORD does valiantly. ¹⁶The right hand of the LORD is exalted; The right hand of the LORD does valiantly. ¹⁷I shall not die, but live, And declare the works of the LORD. ¹⁸ The LORD has chastened me severely, But He has not given me over to death. ¹⁹Open to me the gates of righteousness; I will go through them, *And* I will praise the LORD. ²⁰This is the gate of the LORD, Through which the righteous shall enter. ²¹I will praise You, For You have answered me, And have become my salvation.

- I. Introduction: The year 2020 is the year of Perfect Alignment and Perfect Vision. When you have perfect alignment everything is aligned is such a way that the power, resources and individuals flows in unison bringing greater manifestation of God’s Power and Presence to establish His authority and Kingdom here upon this Earth. When this is in place, WE will see greater glory, greater power and greater manifestations of God’s Presence. Two scriptures that God gave me for us as a church to stand on, believe and embrace for 2020:
 - a. Psalm 2:8 (NKJV) ⁸Ask of Me, and I will give *You* The nations *for* Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth *for* Your possession.
 - i. The Father has said of the Son, “Ask of Me” and “I will give”. Instructions followed by the outcome!
 - ii. God was very specific: Races for your inheritance, ends of the earth for your possession. This also goes into alignment with Ephesians 1:17-19:
 - iii. Ephesians 1:17–19 (NKJV) ¹⁷ that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, ¹⁸ the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what *is* the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power
 - iv. Benefits are new every single morning. Psalm 103:1-5
 - b. John 14:12–14 (NKJV) ¹² “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father. ¹³ And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴ If you ask anything in My name, I will do *it*.
 - i. Jesus said that those who Believe in Me: Thee will be some, sitting in the church today, that speak with their mouths and do not believe in their heart and will not see God’s

Words come alive because they contradict what they speak with their thoughts and actions and they are speaking in doubt versus speaking in faith to receive.

- ii. The works that I do – what we see Jesus do, we should be doing also. A different time, a different cultures, but the same responses should be happening!
- iii. Then He speaks to the disciples and says, “whatever you ask in my name, that I will do.” This wasn’t a crossword puzzle where you have to locate the letters to make a word, sometimes front to back, back to front, side to side, no, Jesus was straightforward with them. The Bible is literally God’s Word to us in Context Form and is our “Covenant” between “us and Jesus Christ who died for us and gave us power through and in Him to accomplish what Jesus began to do.”
- iv. It may be a new year but it is the Word. It may be a new day, but the benefit are new and waiting for us to unlock and begin to experience those new benefits every morning. The benefits actually impact everyone that comes around us.

II. 3 things God said to me about 2020: New Chapter, New Beginning, New Destinations.

- a. New Chapter: Chapters are written in a way which leads us into the next event that builds the foundation that eventually leads to the climax of the story. Each one of you is a chapter in this vision that God has given to me for this city and you have the ability to write your own chapter, your own destiny that will impact God’s Kingdom!
 - i. In order understand what is happening in a story, you must read the chapters because each chapter builds off of another. Some people read the introduction and the ending and then draws a conclusion based off of these two events but have no substance or knowledge what has happened in between that lays the foundation for the main idea of the story.
 - ii. Our mandate is to build this church off of Gods Word Contextually, where we are seeing the Word of God come alive within the lives of the believers and the believers are living the Word of God with anticipation of God’s benefits manifesting in their lives. This is why your faith must be in God’s Word that produces Kingdom Results that impact you, your family (immediate and church), your mission, your destiny.
 - 1. Isaiah 55:11 (NKJV) ¹¹So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper *in the thing* for which I sent it.
 - 2. This must become a reality that we believe, confess and align with that becomes tangible in our lives.

3. You decide to write the chapters in your life and turn the chapter to see what God is going to do. This impacts you and God's Kingdom which includes your family, church, community and any other Kosmos, or anything that has a set order to it. (Matthew 28: 19-20 – (Ethnos – every culture) ; Mark 16:15-18 – (Kosmos – anything with a set order)
- b. New Beginnings. In order to have a New Beginning, there must be an ending. Older things must die, new things must live. It is like the changing of season when you have Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter. In Fall, leaves begin changing and Winter is when things die, to bring forth new life in the Spring. All the trees loose their leaves and flowers loose their pedals during the fall and winter but Spring, they begin to grow leaves and flowers begin to bud and produce beautiful creativities of God. Without death of something, life can not be produced or multiplied.
- i. John 12:23–26 (NKJV) ²³ But Jesus answered them, saying, “The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified. ²⁴ Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain. ²⁵ He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. ²⁶ If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him *My* Father will honor.
 1. Until once sacrifices his/her life for the vision that God has given, it remains just a vision, but once he/she sacrifices his or her life, the vision now becomes a grain of wheat that falls to the ground and dies to self and then begins producing more grain.
 2. New Beginnings start when you die to the old, surrender to God, come under submission to Jesus Christ and begin to live for Him. When you do, you begin to produce the Word of God in your life. But you have to decide to die to the old and live fore the new.
 - ii. New Beginnings signifies the start of a new day, or something new in your life. (2 Corinthians 5:17; Colossians 3:12-17)
 1. Change of a daily Schedule
 2. Change of careers
 3. Education – to become more valuable or an asset.
 4. Change of Commitments
 5. Submission and Obedience.
- c. New Destinations. In order to have a new destination, you must first have a point of origin. Where you start, and where you are going. The reality of where you are and the reality of where God is taking you, or the direction. (Individual, Family and Corporate) Now, you may not

know the outcome, but God has given a direction, so we must go and follow the leading of the Holy Spirit trusting God that we will arrive as long as we are being led by the Holy Spirit.

- i. Romans 8:14 (NKJV) ¹⁴For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.
- ii. Psalm 37:3–5 (NKJV) ³Trust in the LORD, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. ⁴Delight yourself also in the LORD, And He shall give you the desires of your heart. ⁵Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring *it* to pass.
 1. Trust
 2. Do Good
 3. Dwell in the land (God’s word producing Kingdom Results in the Earth)
 4. Delight yourself in the Lord
- iii. Expansion – Individual and Corporately. New Destinations will cause you to expand as an individual because of God’s benefits being new every day. Through this expansion, will be bringing life changes, re-evaluation of what God is calling you to do individually and corporately as a church. Plans of implementation. Set aside time to listen to God and implement.
 1. Ephesians 4:11–16 (NKJV) ¹¹And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, ¹²for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, ¹³till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; ¹⁴that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, ¹⁵but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—¹⁶from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.
 2. God has called the 5-Fold to equip the saints. God has called the saints to work the ministry. This means spiritually and physically/naturally.
 3. Each person is part of the puzzle piece here at LFCC. God has sent you here to help build and move the vision of LFCC in the direction of Kingdom Expansion. The mandate on LFCC is to raise up a supernatural army that is flowing in demonstration of the Holy Spirit impacting the lives of individuals. This can’t happen unless someone else’s vision begins to fall to the ground and dies to begin producing more grain, more fruit, for a bigger harvest.

 - iii. Pastor Mark – logistics, helping move the vision, improving programs we have in place, Pastoral Team, Teaching and Preaching Schedule. DSF Leaders will leaders begin ministering in areas of ministry, leading in some compacity and injecting ideas and thoughts to improve programs.
