Subject: Procedures and Protocols Covid-19 Updated

Procedures and Protocols In-Place at LFCC through July and beyond if needed. The staff of Living Faith Christian Center, Tucson International has been closely monitoring public and private sources of information associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. Because we are conducting constitutionally protected activities of freedom to assemble and worship, we have prayerfully made the decision to resume church services while practicing physical distancing.

If you choose to attend the physical service, you are responsible for your own health and accept the risk of being exposed to any number of illnesses. If you have any concerns about your health or risk, show any signs of the flu or Covid-19, please attend our online services! Our online services will also be available on Sundays at 11:30AM and on Monday nights at 7PM once our midweek classes resume on August 17, 2020.

The following protocols and guidelines are implemented immediately at LFCC to better protect LFCC congregants and our community during this Covid-19 Pandemic. Understand, these are "GUIDELINES" so please help us by respecting these guidelines while at the same time knowing and understanding that the "Natural" of the church is to fellowship and be in communion with one another. LFCC will be conducting two (2) services to accommodate LFCC congregants. If a third service is needed on Sunday to accommodate LFCC congregants, and logistics is in place to accommodate that service, LFCC Leadership will discuss and implement if needed. The first service will be held from 10AM-11AM. During this service, there will be no children's ministries offered and will be a shorter, condensed service. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Service will be a full service to include Kingdom Kids, Nursery and LFCC Youth (Grades 6th-12th). In between the first and second service, "Service Teams" will be sanitizing the sanctuary, lobby, bathrooms, doors, Youth Room (if used) and Fellowship Hall (if used). This will also be done immediately following the second service after everyone has left the building and will include, sanctuary, lobby, sound room, bathrooms, nursery, children's church, administration office, pastors offices, youth room (if used) and Fellowship Hall (if used). After the first service, members will exit the side door in the sanctuary on the East side of the sanctuary. After attending a service, we encourage each individual not to touch their eyes, nose or mouth and use hand sanitizer and wash their hands for at least 20 seconds.

Sunday Morning In-Person Service:

- 10AM - 11AM (No Children's Services Provided)
- 11:30AM - 1PM (Children's, Nursery and Youth)

Fellowship Time of Coffee/Pastries: Currently postponed through July and will be re-evaluated.

Individuals are "recommended" to wear a "Protective Mask". You may remove your mask once you have been seated and are adhering to "Social Distancing" recommendations of six-feet apart from your family unit. Those who have a medical condition that would prevent you from wearing a mask are exempt from this. We are asking that you wear your mask while socializing with others in the church, as you are moving around the church, coming in and leaving. Please help us help you by providing assurance and peace to others that are congregating here at LFCC.

Nursery (2nd Service Only): Only five (5) kids allowed at a time through the end of July. We will re-evaluate at this time to see if more can be accommodated. (0-2 yrs of age) If your child is 3 years of age and is potty trained, he or she can go upstairs with Kingdom Kids. If not, he or she will need to be in the nursery. If there is no space due to social distancing in the nursery, then that child will have to stay with the parents.

Kingdom Kids: Will follow the same protocol and procedures as the adults. They will utilize all three classrooms to accommodate social distancing. When picking children after service, no parent will be allowed to go up the stairs. A Kingdom Kids Volunteer will relay the message upstairs and the kids will be released to their parents. Two side classrooms will accommodate ten (10) kids each while the middle classroom can accommodate twenty (20) kids.

Living Faith Youth: Twenty (20) students max per service.

Foyer: No standing or congregating in the foyer through July 2020 prior to service. With limited spacing within the foyer or lobby, several ministries will be trying to check in kids, etc and we need the lobby cleared while maintaining CDC's recommendation of 6 feet apart.

Sanctuary: Recommend at least 6-feet away from family units. Family units will be seated together by the ushers and a minimum of three (3) chairs will be separating each family unit through July 2020. This will be uncomfortable for some, but in order for us to be able to utilize our space, we must adhere to the seating instructions by the ushers who are following the



instructions from Pastor Randy Winkles. People are still encouraged to worship at the altar and Praise and Worship WILL NOT be restricted.

Alternating Rows: Rows will be alternated for each service. "Do Not Use This Row" signage will be placed on each ending seat reflecting that these rows are not being used. After each service, the rows and chairs being used will be sanitized prior to beginning of the second service.

Hand Sanitizer will be placed at the front entrances, and automatic hand sanitizers will be mounted outside of the men's and women's bathrooms. Soap Dispensers (Men and Women) Automatic Soap Dispensers will be placed in the bathroom facilities.

Bathrooms: We ask that not more than 2 people be in the bathrooms at any one time.

We ask that no one shake hands or hug other people other than your own family. Air high-five people and wave. This is to walk in love toward one another as each of us may have different thresholds of what contact we believe is acceptable.

Staff and volunteers will conduct a self-health assessment before coming onsite. This assessment will include a temperature check for fever, symptoms check and ask if any contact with a confirmed COVID-19 individual has occurred in the last fourteen (14) days.

LFCC Medical Staff will be on campus to evaluate people entering and leaving from our services. CDC Signage will be posted in regards to stopping the spread of Covid-19, symptoms, etc. If someone has been exposed to someone with Covid-19 and they have not self quarantined for fourteen (14) days, they will not be allowed to stay for the service (Honor System – LFCC will not be able to know this). If this does happen, an LFCC Staff Member will meet with them and pray with them prior to leaving if they choose to. If someone is showing signs of Covid-19, they will not be allowed to be in service and we will ask them to leave. Prior to them leaving, a Staff Member will pray and speak with them and follow-up will be conducted. These protocols and procedures are effective immediately.
