#### Icebreaker:

### Message Bible Text:

Genesis 1:27

#### Discussion Questions:

- 1. When have you ever felt insignificant? Why?
- Why do people struggle with being significant?
- 3. What does it personally mean to you to be created in God's image? What are some of the attributes of God that are visible in all people?

## Supplemental Bible Texts:

Colossians 3:10 Philippians 1:6-11 Ephesians 2:10

#### Discussion Questions:

- If we are all created in God's image, what sets us apart as Christians? How do we use our unique attributes to set us apart from unbelievers?
- 2. Why do you personally feel you have value?
- 3. Why is it that other religions have images of their gods and Christians don't?

4. Pastor Tim explained that in Hebrew the word "image" means "shadow." What does a shadow do? Does my life shadow Christ?

### Take-Home Thoughts:

- Think how valuable you must be if Satan is working so hard to get you and Christ was willing to die for you.
- If I feel significant and set apart, how does that affect how I treat others? When others come in contact with me, do they see Christ reflected in me?

- Give thanks for the abundant harvest and beautiful weather. Pray for safety for all involved in gathering the harvest.
