- How would you explain the fallen parts of creation? Read Romans 8:18-23
- 2. What truth about God has been revealed to you through His creation?

Take-Home Thoughts:

- Consider the phrase: "Owners have rights; stewards have responsibilities." What are God's rights? In your vocation or daily life, what are ways we're called to redeem creation?
- Creation is an invitation to know God.
