Icebreaker:

Message Bible Text:

1 Samuel 3:1-11; Key verse 1 Samuel 3:10

Discussion Questions:

- Verse 1 says "in those days the word of the Lord was rare."
 How does this compare to the times we are living in today?
- 2. Why do you think it took Samuel so long to recognize it was God speaking to him? (vs 7-8)
- 3. Eli helped Samuel to discern that it was God speaking to him. Who helps you discern in your life?

Supplemental Bible Texts:

Amos 8:11; Psalm 78:1; Eph 1:17

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How did God first reveal himself to you?
- 2. How do you discern God's will for your life?
- 3. In what area of your life do you specifically need God's discernment over the next 40 days?

Take-Home Thoughts:

- Will you commit yourself to 40 days of prayerful discernment?
- Consider what intentional steps do you need to take to build a stronger prayer life. ("You either schedule Him in, or you schedule Him out.")
