We have just concluded a week of weeks. Holy week is a very significant time in the life of the Christian church. We had three services, each one unique, which complemented the others. On Thursday we had the Lord's Supper. Those of you who were here know it was a bit different from our regular communion services. was very meaningful to us who participated. Then we had the service of the Cross for Good Friday. We went back to see just what was finished when Jesus sacrificed His life and died for us. Of course, on Sunday we thrilled to the message of Resurrection and life in Christ. Because He lives those who are trusting in Him live as well, for time and eternity! Praise God!

In the early church, these three services were called the *triduum*. This meant that the three go together in one package as it were. That is why we have three services in holy week. It is interesting that many churches have discontinued the Thursday and sometimes even the Friday services as well. The thinking must be that they can celebrate the Resurrection without the other services. And, they can. But I am convinced that churches miss out on the *best preparation* for Resurrection Sunday by omitting Holy Thursday and Good Friday.

I am concerned that increasingly churches will abandon the first two services in anticipation of the third. And, that will be a great loss! I know that attendance on Thursday is much less than on Resurrection Sunday. But that should not dampen our commitment to a full schedule of services. Our aim is to worship and praise the Lord
