Twenty-twenty started off like most years - eager anticipation for a full year of ministry initiatives. Ministry plans were in place and we had begun praying for God's direction for a new church plant. As January rolled into February, we celebrated the new arrival of our Children's Pastor, Trevor Berry, and had begun assembling another team to go to El Salvador to build houses for those in desperate need of a safe place to call home. We celebrated 20 years of ministry in March, and had a meaningful AGM reflecting on God's faithfulness over the past few decades. What we did not anticipate was how quickly ministry and life would change. Mid-March saw all our prayerful plans come to a halt as everything closed in the face of a new pandemic. It was during this time, the leadership of MTC came together to start rethinking how best to continue ministry in the face of our new reality. We shifted to online services, introduced a mid-week Worship + Connect time, hosted youth events around bonfires in Fish Creek Park, and engaged in family-fun car scavenger hunts. During this time, we realized that the church plant we had been praying about was in fact our online ministry, so we developed a new website and invested in some necessary technology to help us deliver the best online products we can. We opened our doors for in-person gatherings in the summer, hosted a virtual VBS, and by the time fall rolled around we were back into a rhythm of youth resuming on the weekends and worship services along with MTC Kids programming happening on Sunday mornings. However, it wasn't long before we had to pivot once again to being fully online over the Christmas season.

As much as 2020 took us by surprise, we have been reminded often that none of this caught God by surprise and we've been overwhelmed by the different ministry opportunities and resources He brought to us. Like Jeremiah affirmed to those in exile of God's promises, we too, can take encouragement in those promises that God gives much hope in the midst of whatever circumstances we find ourselves in.
