



Student Ministry at Fair Oaks Safety Protocol for Indoor Programs & Events

While we are just as excited to be together in person indoors, ***please stay home if your student or anyone in your household is experiencing flu-like symptoms, or if you have been exposed to someone who has COVID-19.***

What To Expect:

- We will have students check themselves in with leaders when they arrive at the 2nd floor entrance of the Kids and Youth Center. (This is to help us manage our numbers and to allow us to contact trace if needed).
- Temperature Checks: Our staff will be taking temperatures at check-in. If someone has a temperature exceeding 100.4 degrees they will not be able to participate.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at entrances and in each meeting room.
- Everyone will be required to wear masks while they are indoors. If you forgot one or don't have one, we will provide one for you.
- Maximum number of students and adults in each room will meet state requirements depending on capacity allowed per room with each tier development.
- To avoid sharing equipment, individual supplies will be used as often as possible for games and any other activities. Anything we use will be sanitized and cleaned between uses.
- Chairs will be spaced out for teaching and worship times.
- Activities will be designed to help students maintain social distancing.
- Students will be dismissed from small groups to go outdoors for pick up.
- Rooms would be fully cleaned and sanitized during the week.

Small Groups Indoors:

We have a variety of indoor spaces we can use to facilitate small groups. Again, this will depend on our numbers. The maximum number of kids and adults in each room will meet state requirements depending on capacity allowed per room with each tier development.

- Spaces for small groups include: Youth Café, MS classroom, MS assembly room, MS game room, HS assembly room, HS classroom, Jake's office, HS game room, couch area by stairs.

If our staff/volunteers or a participant tests positive for COVID-19:

- We will have that staff member or volunteer practice two weeks of quarantine.
- If you or your child could have potentially exposed others at a program/event, please contact our team at **covidresponse@fair Oaks.church**.
- We will notify everyone involved, keeping identities confidential.
- In the case that a participant tests positive, the activity may be shut down or temporarily suspended.
