Week 1: Exodus 33:1-17

DISCUSS

Opening Question: How do you read the Bible? Describe your perfect time reading scripture.

1. Before beginning our discussion questions, use the SOAP method as you read through the passage.
2. What are some observable signs that a relationship is suffering from a lack of communication? Why is regular communication so important in a relationship?
3. How has God communicated with you in the past? How do you find time to be with God during your busy week?
4. In the desert the Israelites were hyper focused on getting to the Promised Land rather than enjoying the visible presence of God. Have you been more focused on leaving this season or being with God?

PRAY

As you close this week have your group read through Psalm 46 out loud twice. Then turn verses 10-11 into a closing prayer for you and your group.

THE SOAP BIBLE STUDY METHOD



- S** | **SCRIPTURE**
Work through the text slowly getting a picture of the entire context.
- O** | **OBSERVATION**
What observations do you see in the narrative or events?
- A** | **APPLICATION**
How do you think this applied to people contextually and today?
- P** | **PRAYER**
Ask God to use what you've read to deepen your relationship with him.
