

TRUNK OR TREAT EVENT

OCTOBER 30, 2020

Let's work together to keep everyone safe at Trunk or Treat by taking a quick health assessment of those in your party! **We are excited to see your costumes and give you treats BUT we are asking that you please stay home if you or anyone in your unit:**

- Has had a fever in the past 14 days
- Shows any symptoms of COVID-19
- Has been around anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

EVENT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- Team members will wear gloves and masks when handling, replenishing, and distributing candy.
- Staff and volunteers will have temperature checks the day of event.
- Masks are not required, but our staff and volunteers will be wearing them.
- Our team will creatively distribute candy to bags/buckets so trick-or-treaters don't need to reach into a community bowl for candy.
- Cars and trunks will be spaced out in our back parking lot (4 Parking Spaces between each car to allow for more distance ~30 feet).
- Each trunk will be visibly numbered and we will ask that your party move through the stations in order.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Wear a family-friendly costume!
- Bring your own bag/bucket to collect candy.
- Park in the front or side lots on our church campus.
- Start at the **Check In** Station marked with signage located on the park side of the back parking lot.
- A team member will go over quick instructions before you start.
- Team members will help guide groups from trunk to trunk and help groups stay together. We will ask that you wait to move onto the next trunk until the group ahead of you is done.
