



Coffee Team – This team stocks, manages supplies, and prepares, serves, and clean up coffee in the café on Sunday mornings.

Creative Arts – This team conceptualizes, designs, and creates new sets for the stages (4-6 times/year)

Dare to Care – This team meets the 1st and 3rd Thursday morning of the month to pray over and write personal notes and/or phone calls to various prayer request within our community of faith. They also follow up with new visitors by delivering a gift from K1.

Event Planning Team – This team prepares the details of events hosted by K1, which may include food planning, decorating, marketing, and more.

Facilities Team – This team exists to make sure that we have a facility that is attractive, efficient, and user friendly in helping K1 live out God's mission. Their role is to make sure that the facility can be used to maximize the ministries of the other teams.

Special Projects – construction, electrical, painting, plumbing, etc.

Grounds Team – mow, landscaping, parking lot, etc.

Snow Removal Team – shovel snow from sidewalks

Kitchen Team – to organize and keep the kitchen clean and organized

Fresh Start Mentors – This team is trained to be mentors for new believers, or for young believers renewing their faith. They will walk through the Fresh Start book with the participant and meet with them as a mentor in the faith to help them get a strong start in their spiritual journey.

Funeral Team – This team works with our facility and pastoral staff for any funeral events that we will be hosting, from day of assistance to food preparation, etc.

Funeral Dinners Committee – To organize, provide and serve a meal to the family following a funeral of the K1 congregation.

Kids Worship (Sundays)

Early Childhood Team – To teach/assist with preschool - kindergarten in worship, prayer, story, and active learning of the Bible and God's love for them

Grade School Small Group Leaders – To lead a small group that takes the kids' sermon deeper, using Bible, discussion, reflection, and prayer

Kids Worship Media Team – To assist Children's Ministry by designing and preparing media and training preteens in running sound/media in Kids Worship

Special Ability Ministry (SAMs) – To teach/assist with individuals who have mental and/or physical limitations that need one on one assistance

Worship Buddies – To provide a presence and care with children who attend Kids Worship but need extra attention to participate.

Kid's Welcome Center (Sundays/Wednesdays) – Greet and assist with check in /out and security at the nursery and children's welcome counters.

Kid's Journey (Wednesday nights) –

Early Childhood Team – To teach/assist with preschool – kindergarten in discovering Truth through games, play and activity

Grade School – To lead/assist in various stations that help children discover and embrace a weekly theme that promotes discipleship through games, prayer, discussion, and video.

MOPS Mentor Mom – Someone who walks a few steps ahead and brings perspective on mothering, womanhood and relationships. Through teaching and one-on-one relationships, you communicate with vulnerability and honesty, and provides a foundation for acceptance and trust.

Next Step Team – This team is a part of our Welcome team who specifically connects guests to the church community, providing information on all of our current events, ministry opportunities and services at K1 (including connecting with a Fresh Start mentor).

Nursery & Toddler Ministry (birth – 3yrs) – (Sundays)

Welcome Desk Team – To greet, check in and assist room helpers with babies and toddlers. This position includes changing diapers and is for females only.

Volunteer Team – To give a caring presence with babies and toddlers in their respected age level rooms and assist in Biblical learning activities

Story Team – To provide the telling of the Bible story for 2- & 3-year-olds

Nursery & Toddler Ministry (birth – 3yrs) -- (Wednesday night)

Welcome Desk Team – To greet, check in and assist room helpers with babies and toddlers. This position includes changing diapers and is for females only.

Volunteer Team – To give a caring presence with babies and toddlers in their respected age level rooms

Lifetrack Host Team – Hosts serve as greeters at LIFETRACK events greeting guests, assisting with attendance, distributing materials, and aiding the LIFETRACK leader as necessary. Some team members may help in pre-event emails and phone calls, and material copying and preparation. They also provide lunch on a rotating basis for Lifetrack. Meals can be purchased (and reimbursed) or homemade, serving an average of 10-15 people. Lunch is set out and ready by 12:00p each Sunday.

Lifetrack Childcare Team (Sundays) - Adults and High School students who care and play with children while parents attend Lifetrack.

Marriage Mentoring - Marriage is God's creation, His design for us to experience relational intimacy and love that mirrors the love relationship Christ has with His followers. Our Marriage Mentors help engaged couples prepare for a successful marriage, and help struggling couples dare to believe God can redeem and restore their relationship.

Meal Team - This team is for those who have a gift and passion for cooking. They prepare meals for various trainings, meetings, events, and funerals. They would also participate in meal trains for those in our body who are not in a Small Group that are in difficult circumstances such as health, injury and loss. The meal team also needs individuals who will be on the administrative team who can help organize members for these various events and needs.

Missions Team - This team is involved in helping us stay connected and participating in domestic and international missions (e.g. mission trips, adopting a missions family, etc.).

Office/Admin support - This team consists of volunteers who assist with ongoing, repetitive tasks or assisting with one-time tasks when needs arise. Examples include preparing publications for distribution, covering the front desk, data entry, clerical work, updating bulletin boards, assisting with creation and special projects.

Prime Time Committee – Serve on the leadership team for our senior adults Prime Time ministry to help coordinate events, meals, entertainment, and other activities for the ministry.

Prayer Team – The purpose of the Prayer Team is to lead K1 in being a **“Pray First”** church as we seek God’s guidance on how God wants to use us to bring healing and restoration to our world. To help us live as a **“Pray First”** church, we have various prayer teams, including pastor prayer teams, altar prayer teams, event prayer teams, worship service prayer teams, marriage prayer teams, “new home” prayer teams, etc.

Safe Church Admin Team – To assist in the administration of background checks and monitoring our safe church procedures.

Safety Team – The purpose of the Safety Team is to provide support for the primary mission of K1 by assuring a safe and secure environment for worship, spiritual growth, relationship development, and outreach during all activities on the campus of K1.

Small Group Leaders - We believe that real life change takes place in the context of relationships. As a Small Group Leader, you have the greatest opportunity to create spaces for people to find freedom, to grow in their knowledge of God’s Word, and to experience the power and beauty of Christian community.

Sports Ministry – K1 has teams for basketball and softball as an outreach to our community. Helping with this ministry includes coaching, mentoring, running and stocking concessions, etc.

Technical Arts team – Volunteers serve in our worship ministry through sound, lights, slides, etc.

Video Production Team – This team serves on Sunday morning for our livestreaming, but also works on various video projects for the church at various times during the year.

Pastoral Care Associates - includes hospital visits and shut-in visits for members of our church body. Members of this team have a passion for prayer, are compassionate, and have a desire to express love and support to those in times of need.

Youth Ministry –

Youth Ministry Leaders – This team is passionate about serving, leading, and loving the next generation of teenagers. They do so through games, intentional relationship, and leading small groups on either Sunday or Wednesday nights.

Youth Ministry Meal Team – This team helps provide meals for our students at Sunday Night youth group. If you want to love the next gen through food (which is a HUGE thing for teenagers) this is the team for you!

Welcome Team – This friendly team loves people and makes them feel at home at K1. They welcome guests with a smile, encouragement and personal touch so that hearts are open to the Gospel message and help prepare people for a positive worship experience. Some greeters welcome people into the building, assist with seating, help with directions, and help maintain a distraction-free environment

Worship Team - With vocals or instruments, this dynamic team serves to prepare the way for our guests to encounter the presence of the living God.
