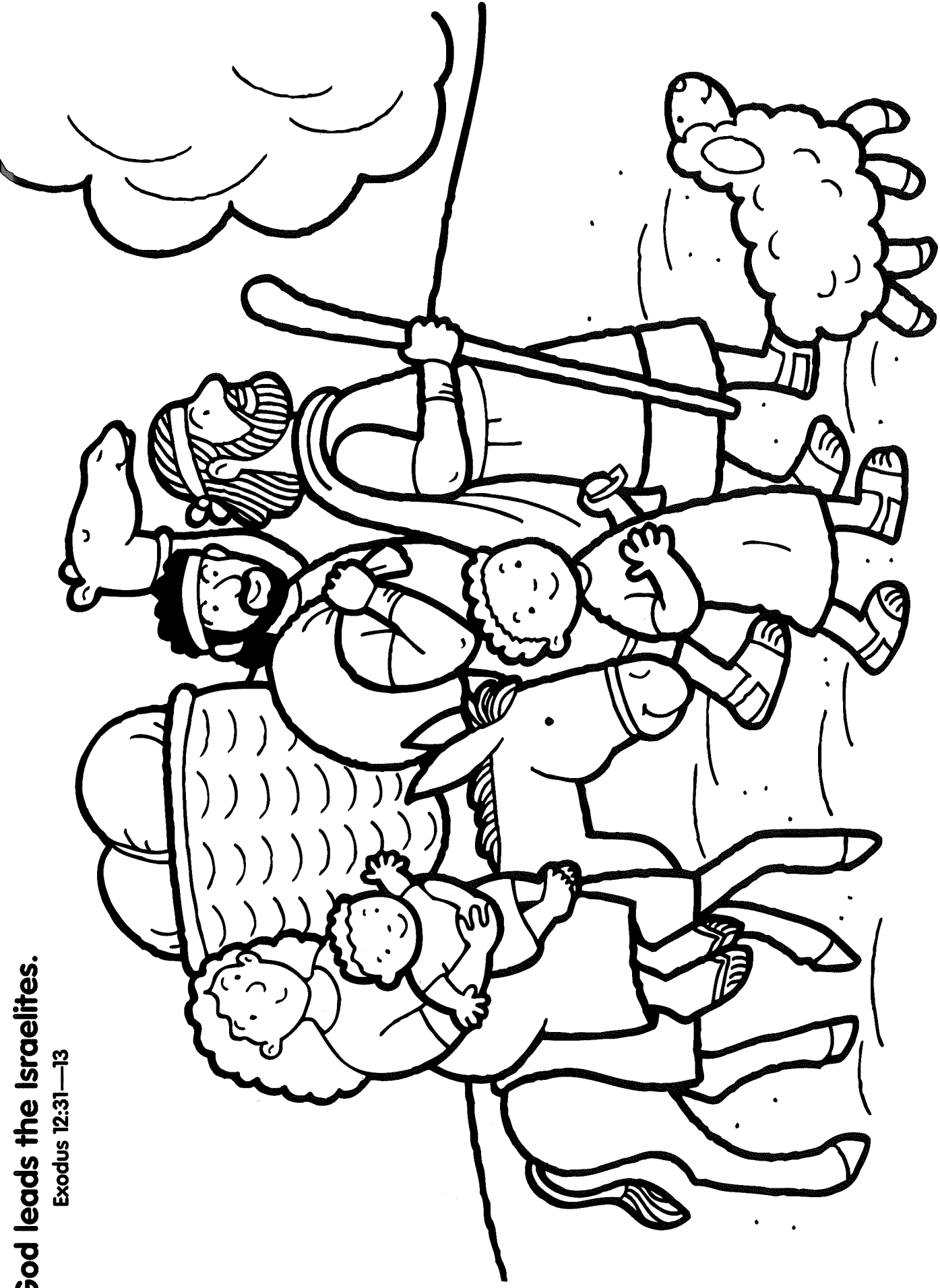


God leads the Israelites.
