Event Descriptions:

Summer Oasis

Summer Oasis is our primary form of gathering in the summer. It will be hosted at the homes of people in the church who love students and want to get to know them. The purpose is to help students get to know more positive role models (Our hosts for the evening), to be able to connect with other students through a time of fellowship, and to be challenged spiritually by a message. We aim to be a non-threatening environment for anyone who is not a Christian or trying to get plugged into a church. We desire to be relational and intentional about how we spend these times together throughout the summer.

June 18-24: Summer Camp - Trails End Ranch

We take students to summer camp at Trail's End Ranch each summer. This is an excellent opportunity to build deeper connections with other students and be challenged spiritually. While at camp, students will have two chapel services a day and set aside devotional time. Trail's End is an adventure camp that offers many ways for students to experience new and exciting events. June 29: Dairy Flo and Volleyball

At 3:00 pm we will meet at Dairy Flo to get ice cream and spend time together. Once everyone has enjoyed their snack and is ready to move on, we will walk down to Van Cleve Park to play volleyball. We will finish wrapping up our time at the park around 5:00 pm but hang out with any students who stick around longer.

This is going to be an amazing hang-out event! We will simply enjoy each other's company as we enjoy some of the simple pleasures of life. We will leave the church at 1:00 pm and return between 9:00-9:30. Students will need some money for dinner and some for Bay Beach. July 18-21: Vacation Bible School
